

Turn on .Net Framework 3.5 (includes 2.0 and 3.0) in Windows 10



The barcode software(www.barcodemaking.com) needs to be able to access the .Net Framework 2.0 and if it has not been turned on, activated in Windows 10, the software will not be able to run and will show an error.

Please note that you will need administrator privileges to install .NET Framework 3.5 (includes .NET 2.0 and 3.0)

Access the Control panel

Move the mouse pointer to the Search button, it's shown by the red arrow marked 1 (image below), then please fill in **Control Panel** , shown by the red arrow marked 2 (image below).




Please note that the Control Panel has a different name for each country, in German its *Systemsteuerung*, in French its *Panneau de configuration* , in Spanish its *Panel de control*, in Swedish its *Kontrollpanelen*


Click on the Control Panel icon, please look at the image below.




In the Control Panel, please click on Programs, please look at the image below.




Please click on the option Turn Windows features on or off, please look at the image below.



.NET Framework 3.5 (includes .NET 2.0 and 3.0) have not been turned on, please look at the image below.



Click in the box as shown, red arrow marked 1. When .NET Framework 3.5 (includes .NET 2.0 and 3.0) have been selected, then please click on the OK button, red arrow marked 2.



That's it, if a restart is requested by Windows 10, then please restart your computer.
