Credit Pay Due Version 4.0

Keep tracks of your monthly credit cards expenses and their payment due date...

1. It lists the monthly expenses for each type of credit card from each bank.
2. It records the outstanding balance for each card prior receiving your credit statement.
3. It helps to sum up the total expenses of your credit cards and total outstanding balance.
4. It reminds you when the credit pay due date with alarm function added so that you can avoid from paying the high interest charged by the banks.
5. It allows you to record other information of your credit card like when it expired and the credit line. It is an optional feature.

1. This page to record the card's related information such as:
 - a. Statement Date(Stat. Date): The date when you receive card statement.
 - b. Account No.(Acc.#):Your card account number.
 - c. Type: eg, gold,silver,complement..etc.
 - d. Payment Due Date(Pay Due): the date due to clear the credit.
 - e. Amount(Amt.): Amount to clear.
 - f. Outstanding Balance(Out Bal.): How much debt bring forward from previous month.
 - g. Finance Charge: How much interest charged by the bank if over due.
 - h. Credit Line: What maximum expenses limi.
 - i. Expired date: When the card expires.
 - j. Alarm!: To remind you to clear the credit payment.
