


# DeepSee





## 1. Introduction

**DeepSee** is nothing but a simple application that allows the user to zoom in a picture so that they can get the color of the pixel they select. To begin with, choose File > Open to open an image file. Then move the magnify marker to set the target area. Now, click on the + button to magnify the selected area.





## 2. Installing DeepSee


Double-click on **setup.exe** in the delivery package initiate the installation process. If your computer doesn't have it yet, DeepSee will first attempt to install **.NET Framework 4**, and you will be prompted for confirmation. (See Screenshot 2.) Then you will proceed to install DeepSee. You can use **Setup.msi** to install the application as long as you already have .NET Framework 4, which DeepSee requires. You can find the application at the following path: C:\Program Files\MacHouse\DeepSee.

## 3. Uninstalling DeepSee


Open Control Panel and choose Uninstall a program. Then double-click on DeepSee to initiate the uninstalling process. (See Screenshot 3.) You can also use the original setup.exe or setup.msi to uninstall the application. (See Screenshot 4.) Additionally, when it starts up for the first time, the application will create a folder, which you need to manually trash. You can locate it easily by opening Preferences and navigate to the System tab.
