

# Free Batch Image Converter

### **Introduction**

Batch Image Converter is a comprehensive and powerful image conversion utility which allows the batch-processing of large numbers of graphics files at the same time to a single uniform image size and file format. You only need to specify the source and destination folders and the program will scan the source folder for image files...



### **Interface**

Source Folder:

Assign the Source and Destination folders. These folders cannot be the same.

Width (in pixels):  Height (in pixels):

Set the height and the width for the new image. Height is disabled when Preserve Aspect Ratio is enabled.

☒ Preserve aspect ratio (proportional)

Forces proportional resizing of the image (Width is leading).

☒ Filenames to lower case

The filenames of the new images will be all lower case.

☒ Filename whitespace to underscores

All whitespace in the new filenames will be replaced with underscore characters.

☒ Use file-naming convention  
Part 1   
Part 2   
Part 3

The output filenames will be prefixed with Part 1, 2 and 3 texts, separated by an underscore.

You can customize the naming conventions to suit your needs. Example of a file name:

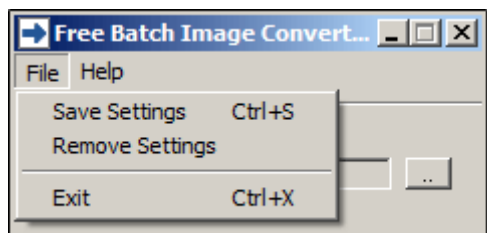
`Part1_Part2_Part3_OriginalFileName.jpg`

☒ Leave file format unchanged  
☐ Convert to GIF file format  
☐ Convert to JPEG file format

When you select the Leave file format unchanged –option, Free Batch Image Converter only resizes the images. Otherwise the output files will be either GIF or JPEG format images.

Image Quality Level

Drag the slider to set the level of image quality.



Use Save Settings to save all the current settings to the registry, or Remove Settings to delete them from the registry. Run Free Batch Image Converter as Administrator under Window Vista!

### **Quick Tips**

- Free Batch Image Converter allows you to choose from five degrees of image quality, ranging from poor quality images to superb quality images. The higher value results in better quality of the processed images but it will also increase the file size. Large files are unfit for webpages, while poor quality images will negatively affect the look of the website.
- Although Free Batch Image Converter is capable of processing image files over a network, it dramatically decreases the processing speed. The advice is to copy the target image files to your local file system for processing and copy them back later when done.

### **Get Support**

This application is designed for Windows XP, but it should work correctly on Windows 98 Second Edition to Windows Vista (Run as Administrator at least once!).
