Info Box Settings

You can manipulate the border, size, font, color and background of the info boxes which are displayed below as a preview.

Select the target element of your info box

You have four choices of how you want the info box to be displayed.

You can choose if you want your info box to appear when the user hovers their mouse over either one of the following:-

- **A Text link:** Enter the text for the link and the link's URL.
- **An Image:** Browse your computer for an image, or enter the image's URL
- **A Table Cell:** For example, over a particular `<td>` tag
- **A Layer:** For example, over a particular division `<div>` tag.

Step 2: Select the target element for your Info Box

☐ Image (This option creates the info box over an image. Select a local image or enter an image url)

☐ Table Cell (This option creates the info box over a html table cell, for example an specific `<td>` tag)

Once done, click the next button.




There are two ways to save your info box configuration:-
