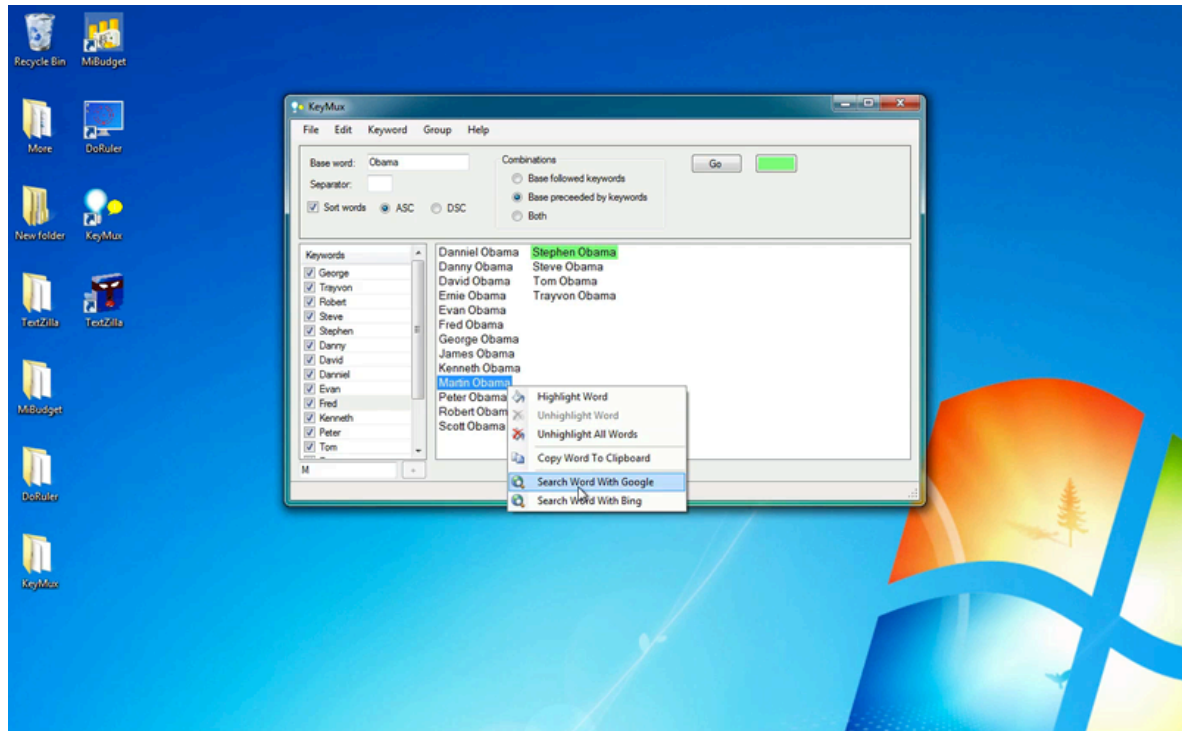

1. Introduction

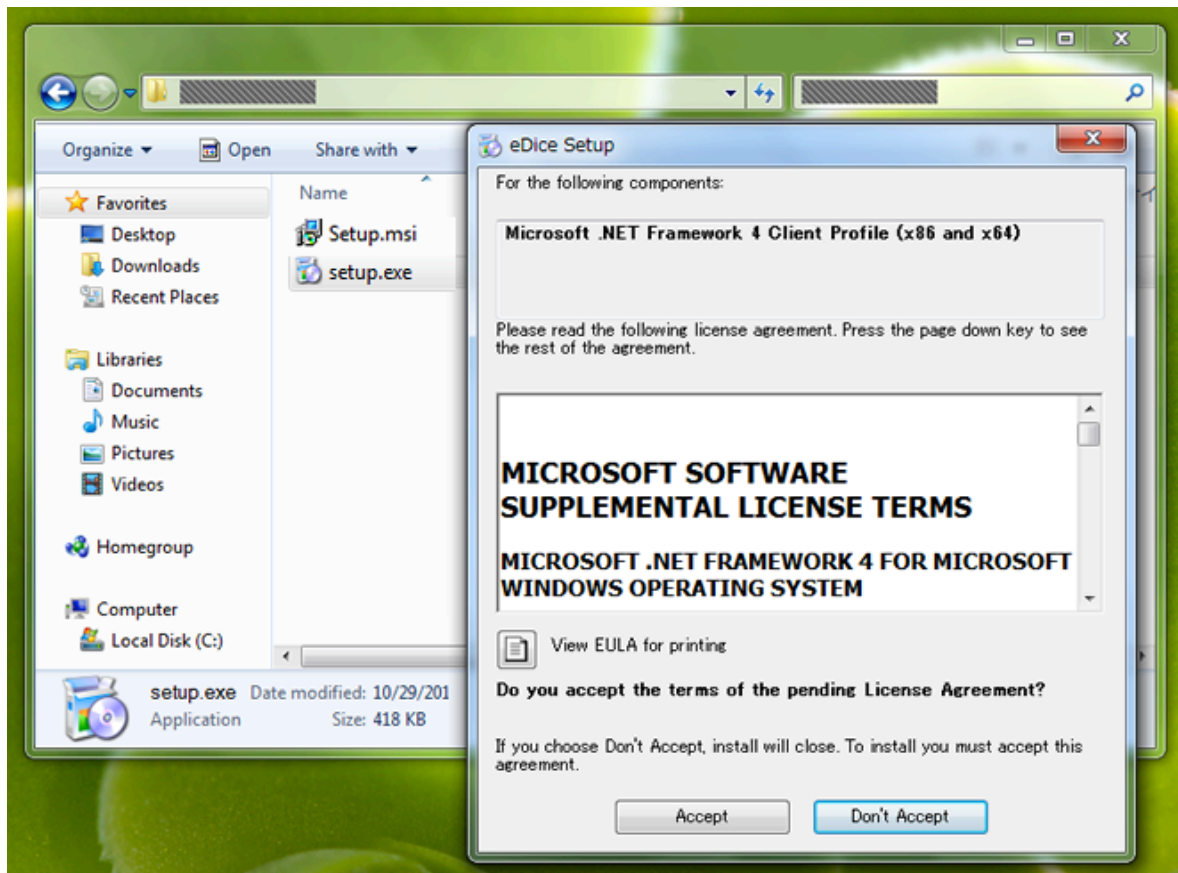
Making up a good name (application names, child names...) can take longer than necessary. As for software application names, even when you know you just need to append a keyword to a base name, a good solution won't be easy to come by. In fact, we even change application names at least a few times while developing a new software title.

Sometimes, we end up naming an application so badly that it cannot be found with a quick Google search. So we've developed **KeyMux**.

We've developed it so that users can come up with name candidates quickly by appending keywords to a base name.



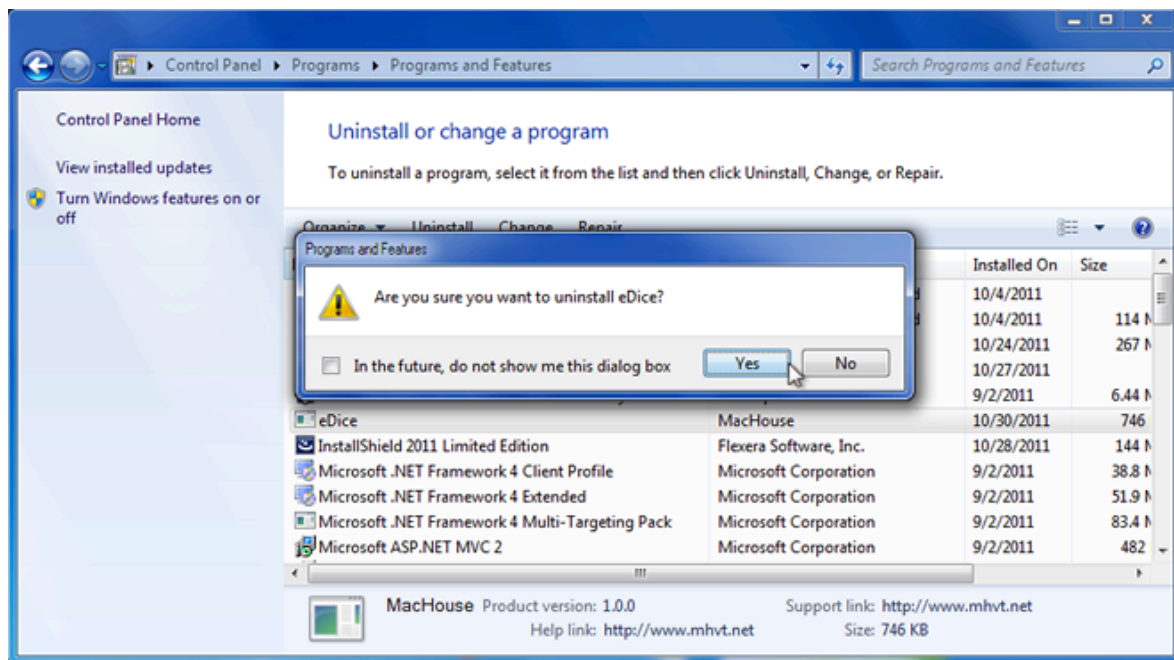

2. Installing KeyMux

Double-click on **setup.exe** in the delivery package initiate the installation process. If your computer doesn't have it yet, KeyMux will first attempt to install **.NET Framework 4**, and you will be prompted for confirmation. (See Screenshot 2.) Then you will proceed to install KeyMux. You can use **Setup.msi** to install the application as long as you already have .NET Framework 4, which KeyMux requires. You can find the application at the following path: C:\Program Files\MacHouse\KeyMux.

3. Uninstalling KeyMux

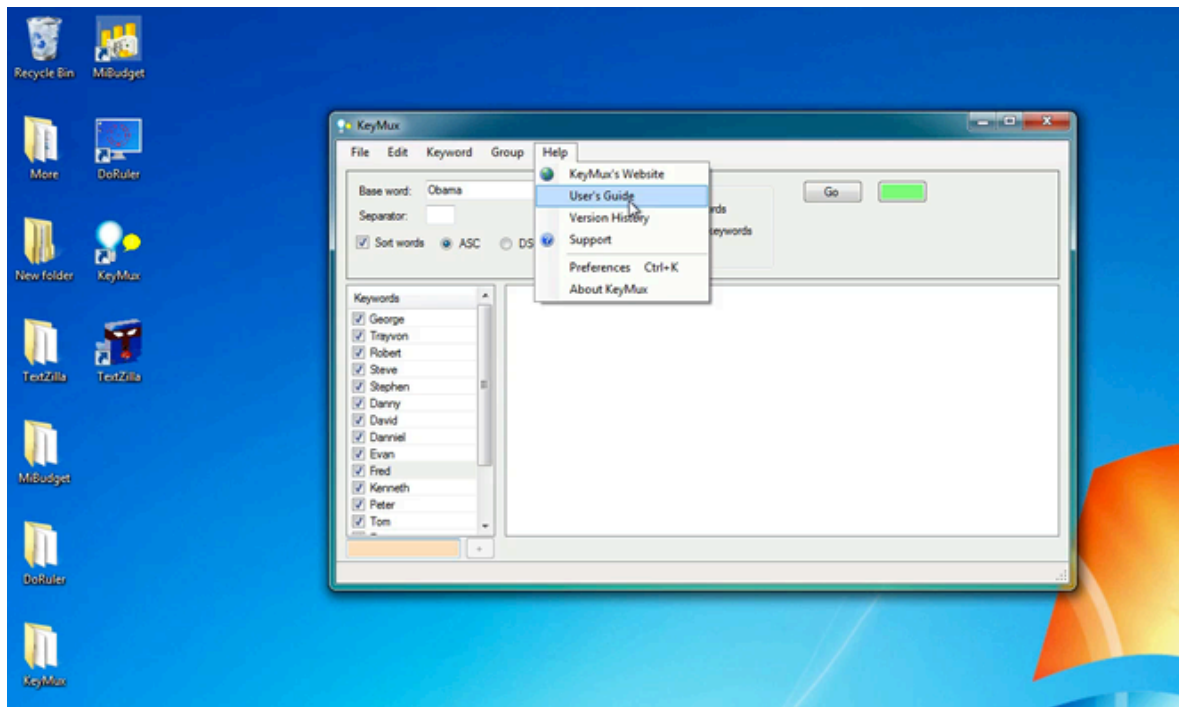
Open Control Panel and choose Uninstall a program. Then double-click on KeyMux to initiate the uninstalling process. (See Screenshot 3.) You can also use the original setup.exe or setup.msi to uninstall the application. (See Screenshot 4.) Additionally, when it starts up for the first time, the application will create a folder, which you need to manually trash. You can locate it easily by opening Preferences and navigate to the System tab.
