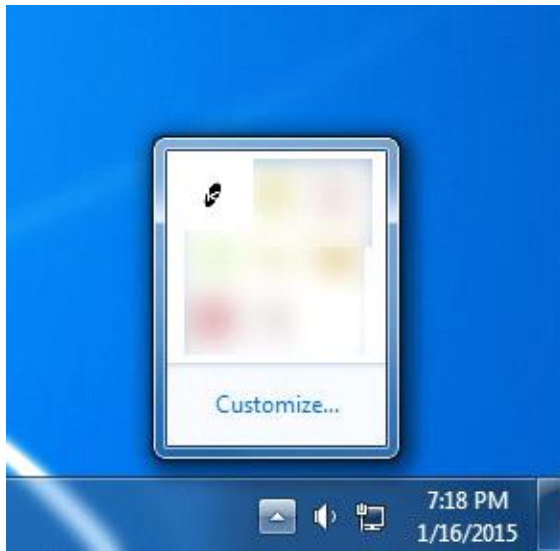


Keytell Basic

First run

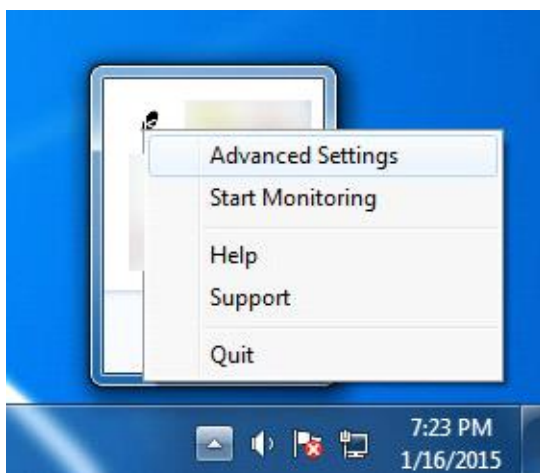
When you run the program for the first time, you will find the icon at the system tray. The main form or user interface will not show up in your desktop.

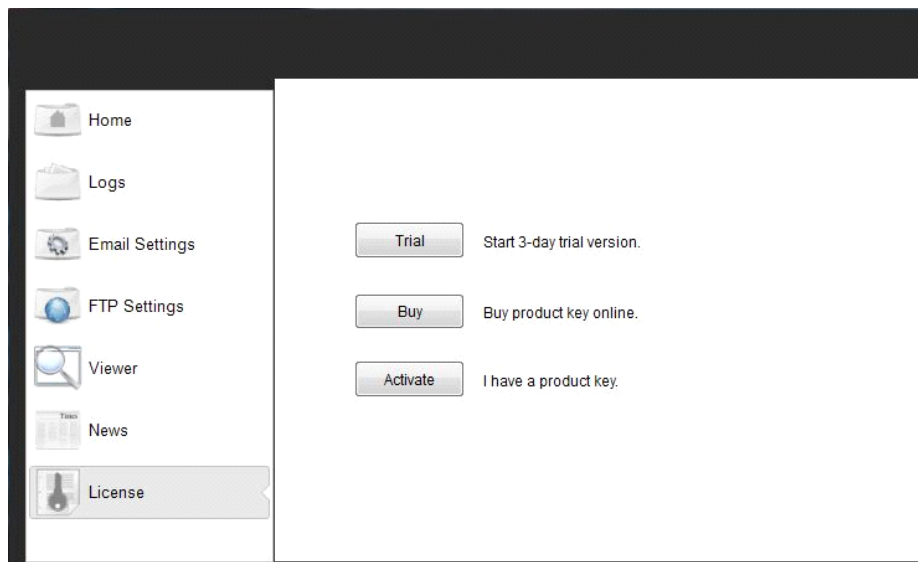
You can double click the system tray icon or right click it and select "advanced settings".

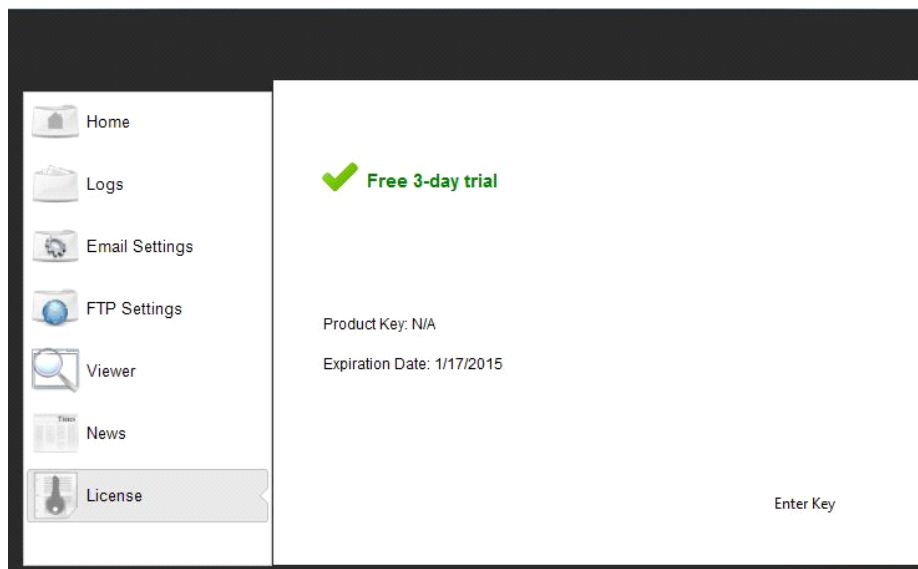
This will show the user interface in your desktop.

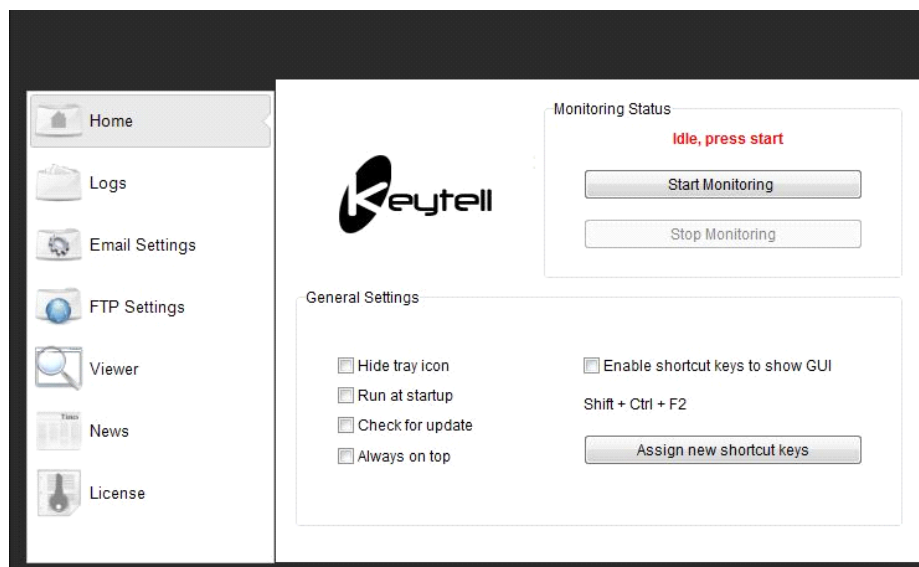


Menus

1. Home

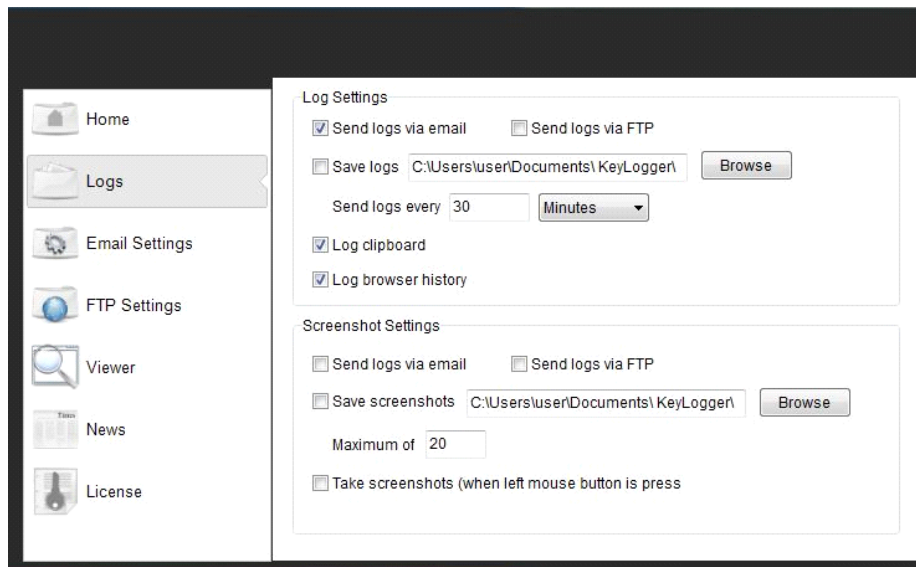


2. Logs

You can set how many screenshots to be send, the default is 20.

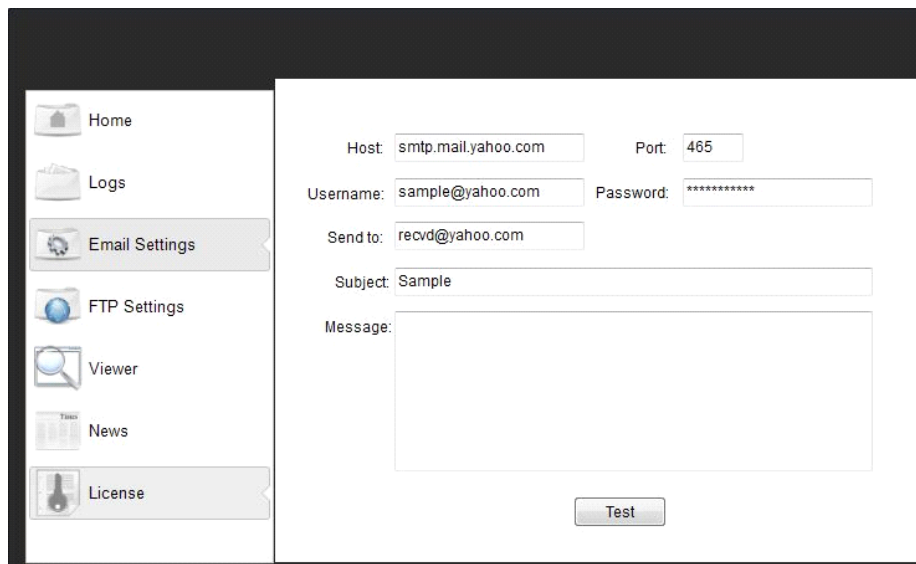

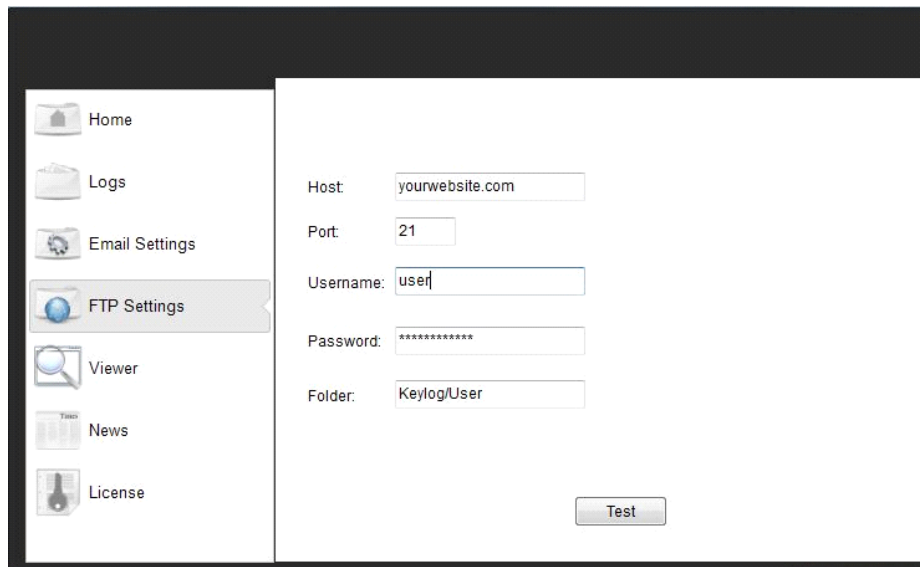

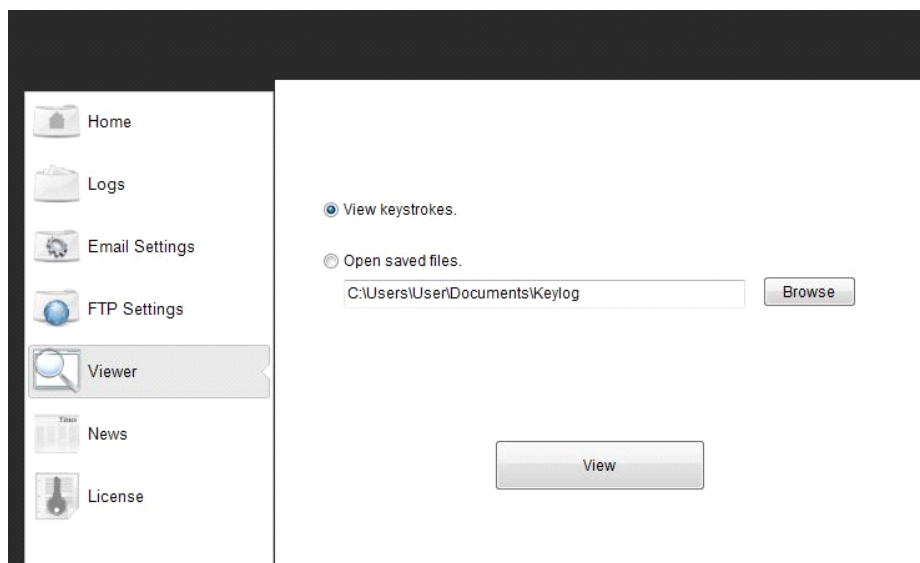

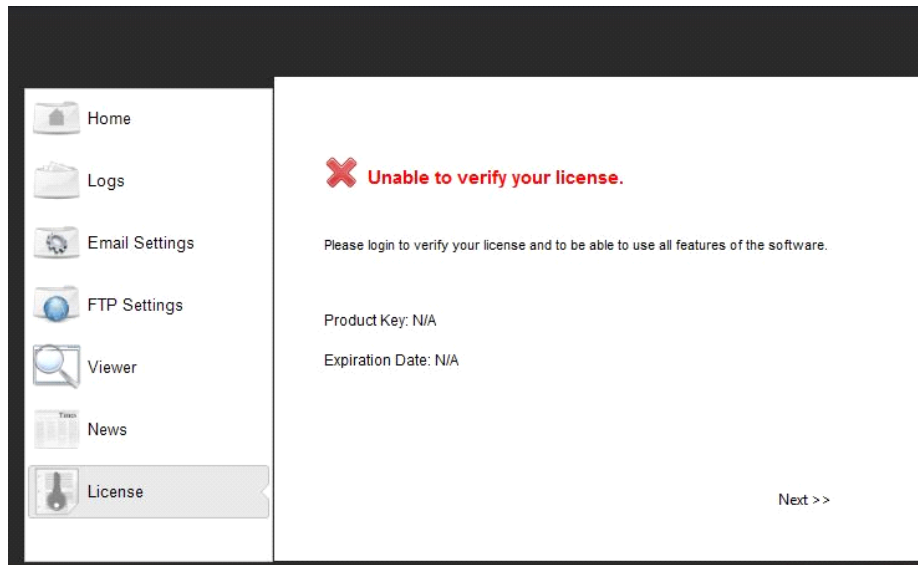
6. News

7. License

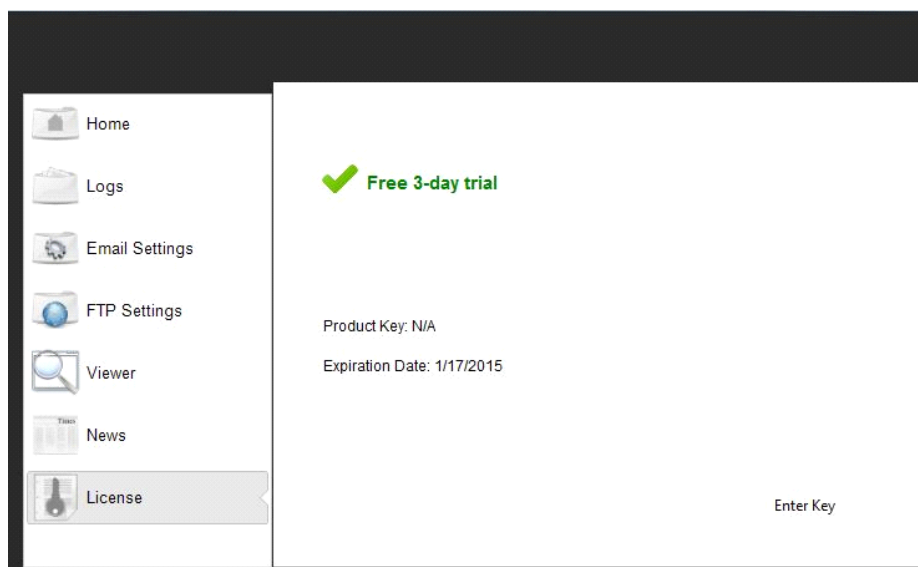
- view the information of your license.

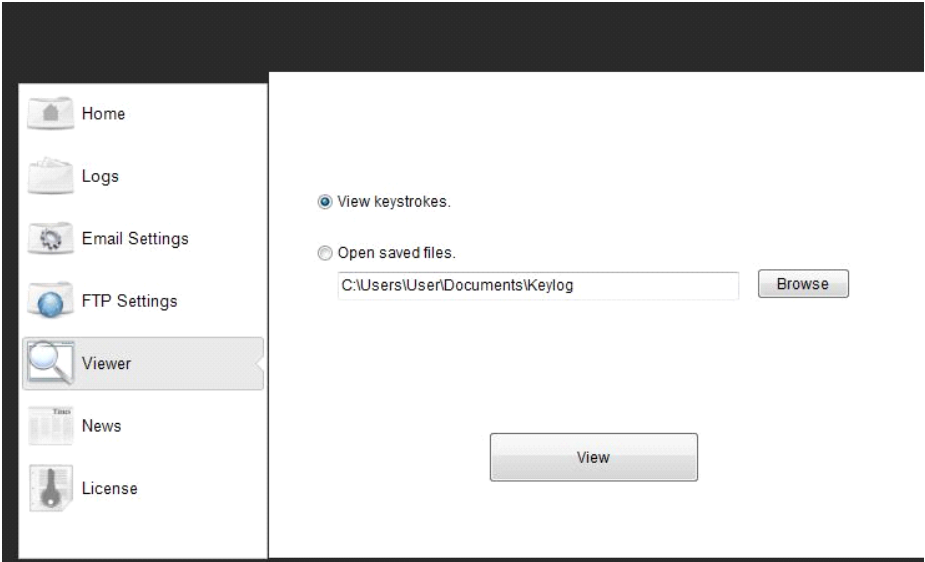

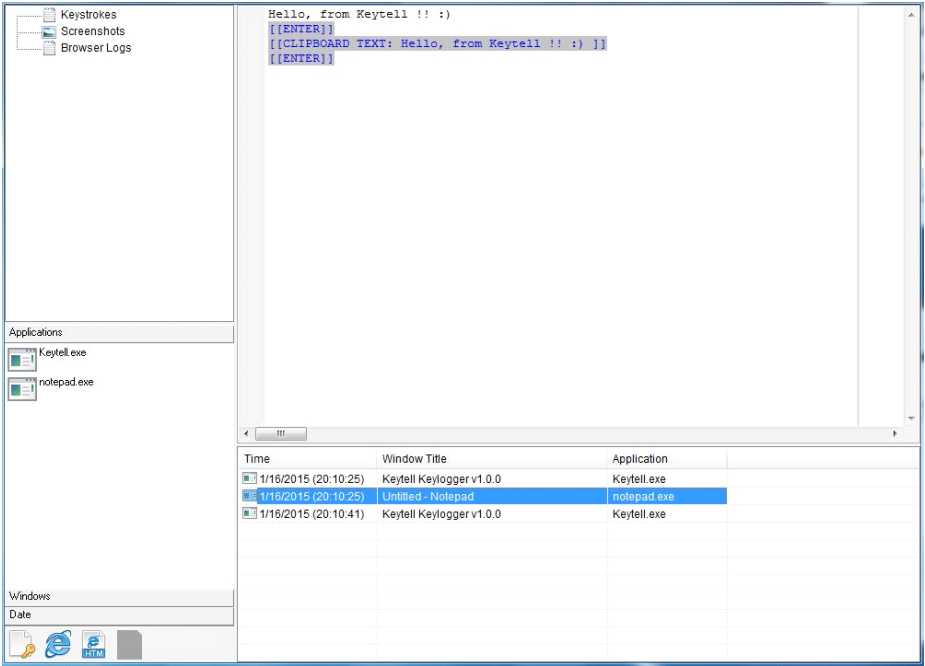

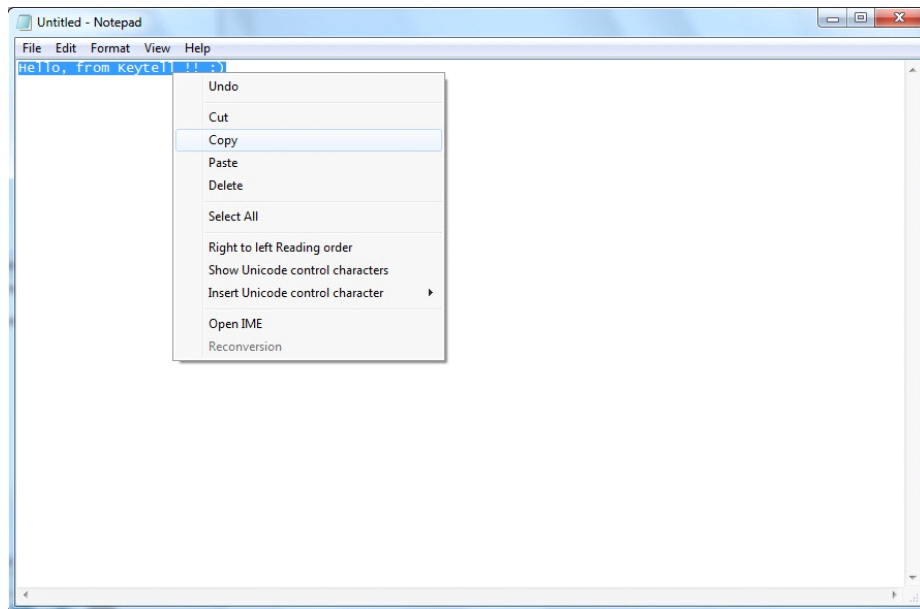
A sample shown in image 13, viewing the keystrokes log.

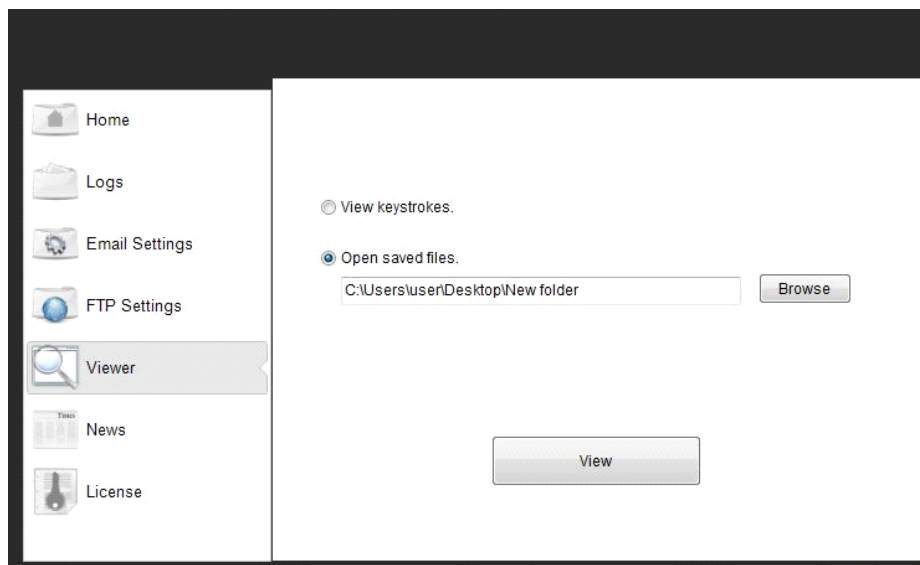

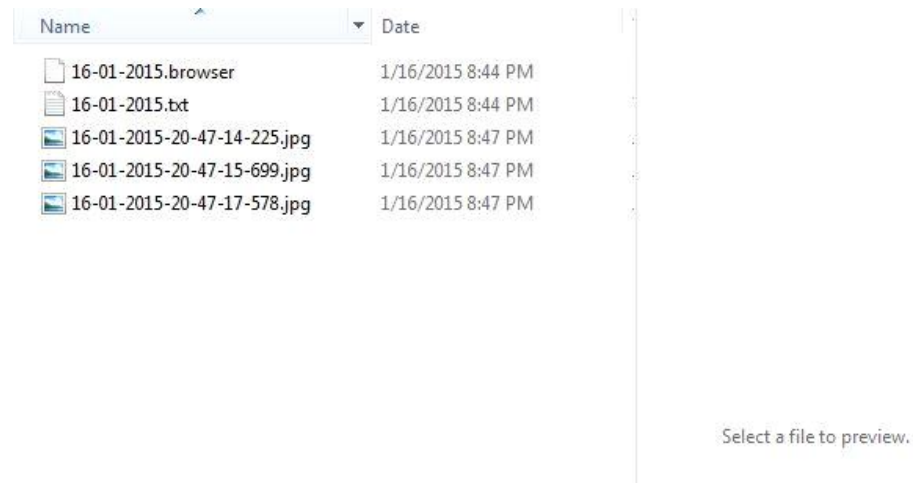

Shown in image 16 are the type of files or file extension that it can view. Your saved logs have this file extensions.

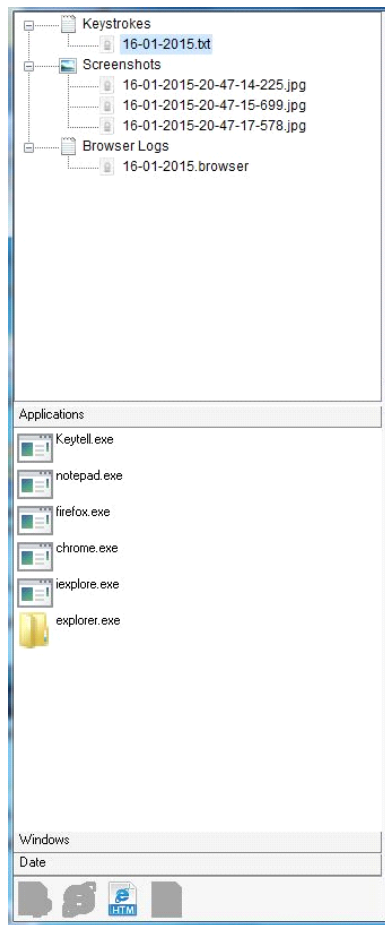
- .txt* is for keystrokes log
