





1. Introduction

MsgRoll is an auto-scrolling message board for yourself. It lets you quickly write messages. Remind yourself of events that are immediately important to you. When there are more than three messages, MsgRoll will automatically roll these messages for you so that you will see them all with your hands free.





2. Installing MsgRoll


Double-click on **setup.exe** in the delivery package initiate the installation process. If your computer doesn't have it yet, MsgRoll will first attempt to install **.NET Framework 4**, and you will be prompted for confirmation. (See Screenshot 2.) Then you will proceed to install MsgRoll. You can use **Setup.msi** to install the application as long as you already have .NET Framework 4, which MsgRoll requires. You can find the application at the following path: C:\Program Files\MacHouse\MsgRoll.

3. Uninstalling MsgRoll


Open Control Panel and choose Uninstall a program. Then double-click on MsgRoll to initiate the uninstalling process. (See Screenshot 3.) You can also use the original setup.exe or setup.msi to uninstall the application. (See Screenshot 4.) Additionally, when it starts up for the first time, the application will create a folder, which you need to manually trash. You can locate it easily by opening Preferences and navigate to the System tab.
