

## **mySync – v. 0.8**

### **Installation Instructions**

Extract the rar file to a directory on your computer – ensure all files remain in the same folder (the mdb and the exe).

Create a shortcut should you desire.. to the mySync.exe application.

### **How to use mySync**

Run the program.

Once in you will need to edit your sites.

Sites are FTP servers where you will store your files.

Click on File --> Sites List.

Add your site or modify any existing ones as you desire.

You next need to add your folders to sync.. At the main mySync window click File --> Folders List.

To Add a folder click the add button and fill in the path (for example "[c:\temp](#)")

Select the server you wish to back up the information to.

Tick if you would like subdirectories of this folder saved too.

Once all set up for your folders and sites.. click on the "Sync --> Now" menu.

mySync should upload all non-listed or changed files!

You can also force mysync to run a backup and then exit using command line "/SYNC"  
i.e. "mysync.exe /SYNC"

### **How to get help**

This program is provided free and is fully functional, time to create and develop the program is taken out of a very busy schedule.. should you wish to support development of the software please donate what you feel just.

### **FAQ**

*Q. I get an error about ActiveX not being able to create something, what does this mean?*  
Please get in touch, this error should not show!

*Q. Some files give "error code: 32" when mySync attempts to back them up.. what does this mean?*

Error 32 means the file is currently locked and in use.. this is especially the case with microsoft access databases in use by software. Try closing all programs which may have that file locked.

*Q. mySync crashes when I click Sync Now!*

This is probably because an ftp profile associated with a directory has been deleted.. try going through all the directories in the setup and see if you get a message saying one is missing its ftp profile.

## **ChangeLog**

  - Added functions to clear all the status information so all files can be re-copied!

  - Put in controls to stop System Volume Information causing permission errors.

  - Changed database access to tolerate ' in filenames, v0.5 and lower will encounter an sql error upon a file named "Brat's File" etc..
  - Made the main form resizeable
  - Improved the maximum files that can be stored in the database
  - Noted that the max length of a filepath and name can be 255 chars long... this has only been noted once on a file in an internet explorer cache. I will watch to see if this affects more people.
  - In an attempt to stop the system crashing the maximum lines in the status log has been set to 400, after which it will clear and start again.

  - Happy new year
  - Added icon \o/
  - Added Command mode "/SYNC" to allow "at" automated scheduled jobs or startup jobs etc.

  - Changed the way the system calculates if a file has been changed.. the previous system caused problems when BST switched to GMT (uk users) and uploaded ALL the files again.. however.. this change means that all files will show as changed after running the new version while it builds its new database... sorry! However it will fix more problems in the future.

  - Fixed a bug where the status screen would blank out while in the first stages of connecting to a remote ftp.

  - Added support for login failure when doing a sync..when login fails the program will not attempt to send all files!
  - Allowed status window to be sent to back and also made the status lines larger
