3. Installation

3.1. Permissions

Make sure that all directories listed below have full written permissions equal to 777 or 0777.

- /app/code/local/
- /app/design/adminhtml/default/default/layout/
- /app/design/adminhtml/default/default/template/
- /app/design/frontend/base/default/layout/
- /app/design/frontend/base/default/template/
- /app/etc/modules/
- /skin/frontend/base/default/js/

Change all permissions back after installation.

3.2. Disable Compilation

Log into **Magento Admin Panel** (usually <http://<yourhost>/admin>) and go to **System -> Tools -> Compilation** and disable the compilation. You can run the compilation process again if need after installation.

3.3. Upload files

Upload \app and \skin directories from the extension to the installation directory of your Magento using a FTP client.

3.4. Clear Magento Cache

Log into **Magento Admin Panel** and go to **System -> Cache Management** and clear the store cache.

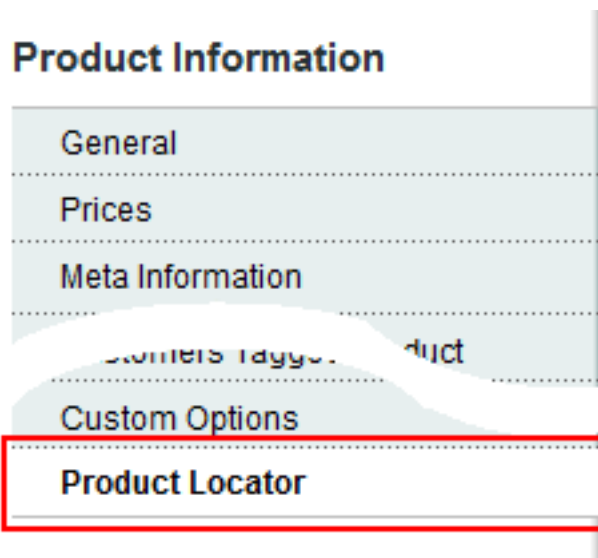
3.5. Re-login

Log out and log back into **Magento Admin Panel**.

4. Usage

4.1. Adding an address to the product

Log into **Magento Admin Panel** and go to **Catalog -> Manage Products**. Open particular product to and click on *Product Locator* tab under *Product Information* at the left column.

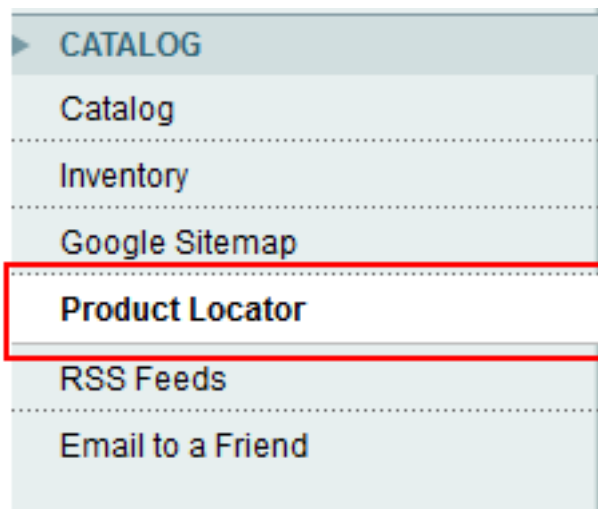


Enter the required address information of the product in the form that appears.

4.2. Enable/Disable extension

Log into **Magento Admin Panel** and go to **System -> Configuration**. Find *Catalog* section at the left menu and click on *Product Locator* tab.



To enable extension set *Enabled* drop-down to 'Yes' or selected 'No' to disable extension. To select the type of group use the drop-down *Group By* (available options are Category or City).

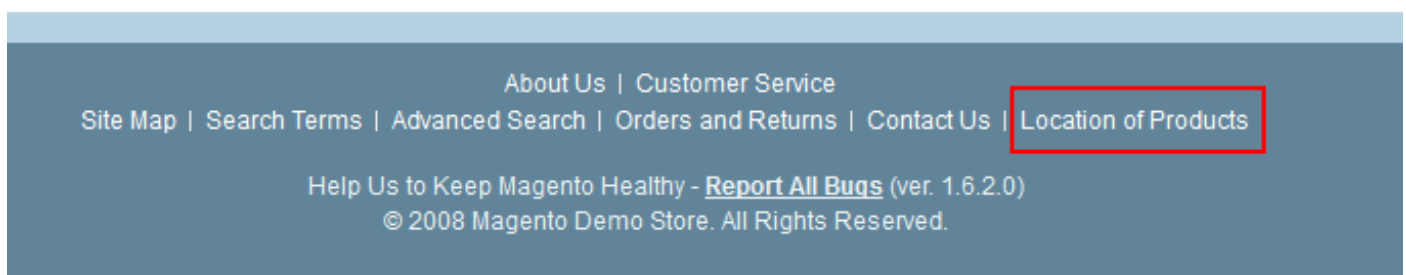

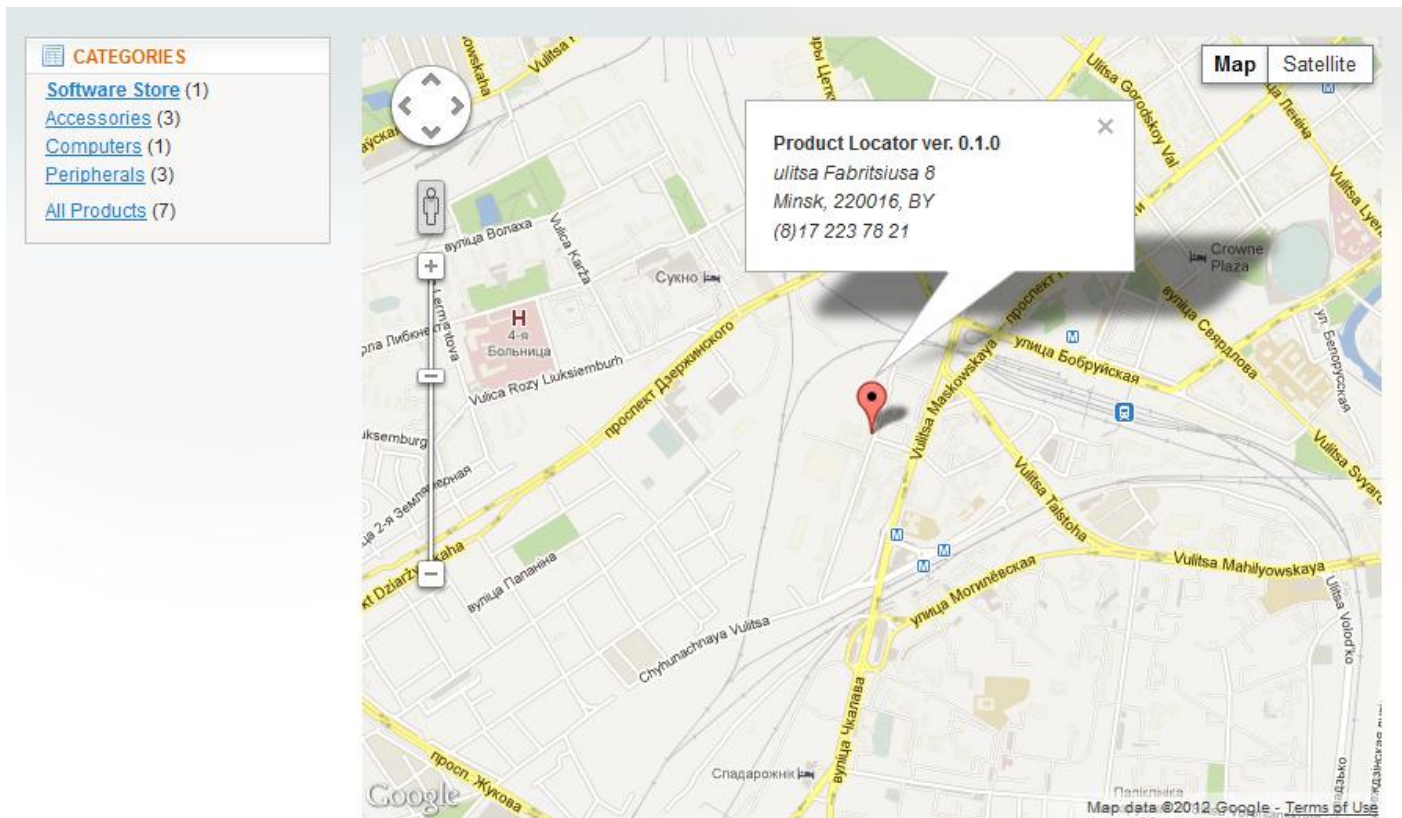
Clear Magento Cache each time you enabled/disabled extension.

4.3. Location of Products

When extension is enabled users will be able to see *Location of Products* link in the footer.



The link will opens a page with a *Google Maps* and a list of products (only those products which have address and/or lat-lng attributes) grouped by categories or cities. The user can filter products by category/city or choose 'All Products' option.



5. Uninstallation

5.1. Disable Extension

Log into **Magento Admin Panel** and go to **System -> Configuration**. Find *Catalog* section at the left menu and click on *Product Locator* tab. Set *Enabled* drop-down to 'No'.

5.2. Delete files and folders

Delete files and folders listed below using a FTP client.

BE VERY CAREFUL WHEN DELETING FILES OR FOLDERS. IT'S POSSIBLE YOU COULD ACCIDENTALLY DELETE THE WRONG FILES OR FOLDERS.

Files:

- /app/design/adminhtml/default/default/layout/productlocator.xml
- /app/design/frontend/base/default/layout/productlocator.xml
- /app/etc/modules/Scand_ProductLocator.xml
- /skin/frontend/base/default/js/scand/productlocator.js

Folders:

- /app/code/local/Scand/ProductLocator/
- /app/design/adminhtml/default/default/template/productlocator/
- /app/design/frontend/base/default/template/productlocator/

5.3. Clear Magento Cache

Log into **Magento Admin Panel** and go to **System -> Cache Management** and clear the store cache.
