Thanks for evaluating ScriptFire – the ultimate script scheduling plug-in for FileMaker

Installation Instructions

Be sure to read the license agreement enclosed with this package before you start using the plug-in since you agree to the terms of the trial license agreement as soon as you start using the software.

To install the correct plug-in version of ScriptFire, open the folder 'Plug-In' and choose the plug-in file from the correct sub-folders according to your operating system and FileMaker version.

Close FileMaker before installing the plug-in.

ScriptFire comes in four versions:

- Windows for FileMaker 5.x and 6
- Windows for FileMaker 7 and 8
- Macintosh for FileMaker 5.x and 6
- Macintosh for FileMaker 7 and 8

Copy the ScriptFire plug-in into the following folder:

Windows:

FileMaker 5.x and 6: FileMaker *System* folder

FileMaker 7 and 8: FileMaker *Extensions* folder

Macintosh:

FileMaker 5.x and 6: *FileMaker Extensions* folder

FileMaker 7 and 8: *Extensions* folder

The folder you have to look for is located in the FileMaker application folder.

After installing ScriptFire explore its functionality using the *QuickStart* file that is part of the download package.

Registration Information

ScriptFire is commercial shareware. You are allowed to try this FileMaker plug-in for 14 days. After that the plug-in cannot be used any longer without registration. To remove this restriction, please register ScriptFire at: <http://www.dacons.net/fmplugins/scriptfire/licenses>
