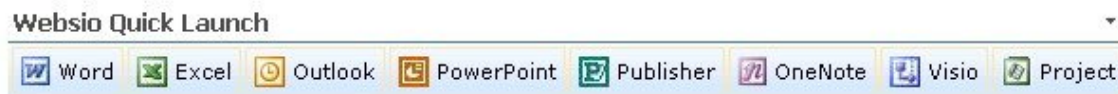

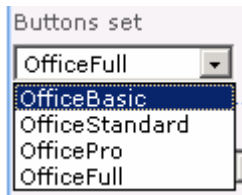

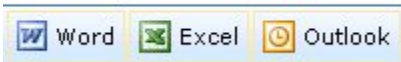
Buttons set



The Web Part contains four built-in buttons sets:

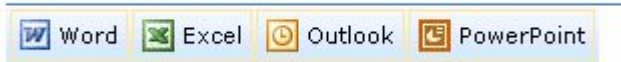
1. OfficeBasic – select this option to see Word, Excel and Outlook buttons.

Webzio Quick Launch



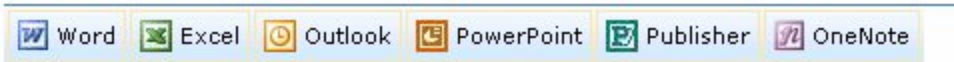
2. OfficeStandard - select this option to see Word, Excel, Outlook and PowerPoint buttons.

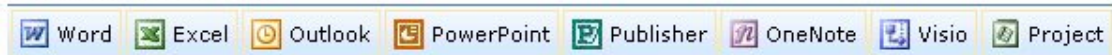
3. OfficePro - select this option to see Word, Excel, Outlook, PowerPoint, Publisher and OneNote buttons.

4. OfficeFull - select this option to see Word, Excel, Outlook, PowerPoint, Publisher, OneNote, Visio and Project buttons.

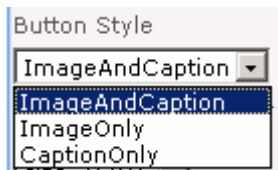

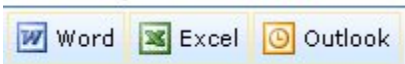
Button Style



The property determinates buttons style:

1. ImageAndCaption – icon and caption.

2. Image Only – icon only.

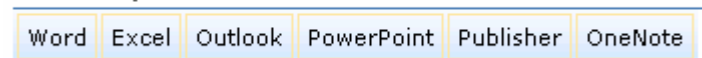
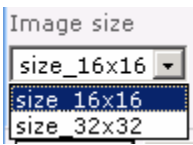


Image size

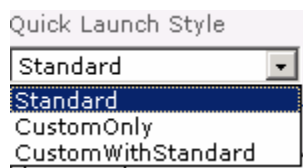


The property determinates image size.

1. 16x16 pixels.
2. 32x32 pixels.



Quick Launch Style



The property determinates which type of style you want apply for the Quick Launch.

1. Standard – only standard buttons will be displayed in the Web Part.
The set of standard buttons may be defined by property "Buttons set"
2. Custom Only – only custom buttons will be displayed in the Web Part.
The set of custom buttons may be defined by property "Custom XML".
You can use "demo.xml" file as sample for customization your own toolbar.
3. CustomWithStandard – both standard and custom buttons will be displayed in the Web Part.

The set of standard buttons may be defined by property "Buttons set"

The set of custom buttons may be defined by property "Custom XML". You can use "demo.xml" file as sample for customization your own toolbar.

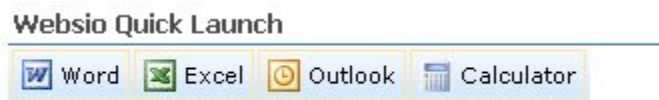

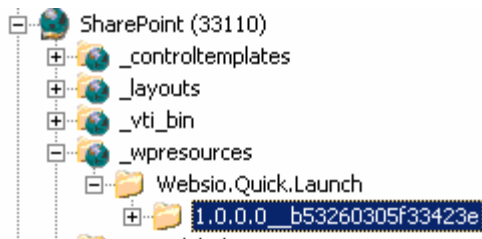
Custom XML

The property determinates name (or full path) the file which includes XML for set of custom bottoms.

If value of the property doesn't contain full path you have to put the file to the resources directory of the Quick Launch Web Part.

To open the resources directory:

- Open IIS Manager
- Open your SPS/WSS site
- Navigate to Websio.Quick.Launch resources as shown on the picture:



- Select "Open" from right-click menu

The resources directory of the Web Part contains "demo.xml" file as simple example to customize your Quick Launch to run Windows Calculator.

- <IMAGE_16> - Image 16x16 pixels. Must be placed in the web part resources folder
- <IMAGE_32> - Image 32x32 pixels. Must be placed in the web part resources folder
- <ALT> - tooltip
- <CAPTION> - button caption
- <APPLICATION> - full path to your application .exe file

Websio Quick Launch CSS

You can change visual style of the Web Part by editing WebsioQuickLaunch.css file.

You can find it in the resources folder of the web part.

- wsioButton, wsioButtonSelected and wsioButtonPressed – styles of the button.
- wsioBar – external table.
- wsioInnerTable – inner table. Each button build as table with two cells: one for image and another for caption.
- wsioInnerImageCell – image cell.
- wsioInnerButtonText – button cell.
- wsioInnerImage – image style.

Server Requirements

- Microsoft Windows SharePoint Services (WSS) v2.0 OR
- MS Office SharePoint Portal Server 2003 (SPS) OR
- MOSS 2007 B2TR

Client Requirements

- MS Internet Explorer 6.0 or later version

Installation Steps

Server installation

- Unzip the "Websio Quick Launch Web Part.zip" file on your WSS/SPS Windows 2003 Server.
- Double-Click the .msi file in order to begin the installation wizard.
