

Simple IP Changer Ver 1.0

Description:

This simple batch file help you quickly change between two IP configurations: Static & DHCP IPs. There are several other fancy GUI utilities to do this task, but they don't work on my machine, esp.

Windows 8, so I decided to write this simple script to automate the task.

Supported O/S:

All Windows (including Win 8x)

Running Instructions:

1. Open the **Simple_IP_Changer.bat** file in any text editor
2. Now set your desired parameters, as shown below:

SET /P Choice=Please enter your choice
IF "%Choice%"=="D" GOTO Dhcp_Address
IF "%Choice%"=="d" GOTO Dhcp_Address

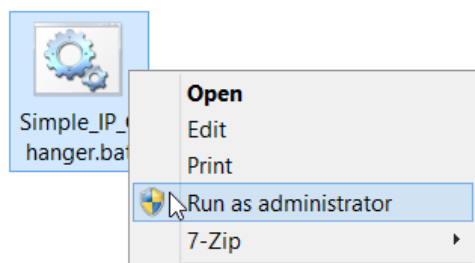

Set the desired Static IP configuration here


Set the desired Primary & Secondary DNS servers here. Presently, these value point to Google public DNS Servers

Set the Interface name, for which you wish to change the IPs. I am using this for my Wi-Fi adapter, but if you use it for your LAN card, the typical name is **Local Area Network**. You can find the correct name by going to Control Panel and seeing Network Adapters.

3. Click Save & Close
4. That's it. You are all set. Right click & run the file now with Admin privileges ☺
