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3. The customer must supply Rockwerk Books with any crypto-analysis software used to decrypt the file.
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5. If the decryption was done by a distributed network, Rockwerk Books must be able to submit to the distributed network, an encrypted file, of Rockwerk Books choosing, encrypted with the software used by the customer. The valid decryption of said file will be the deciding factor if the customer has met the challenge.
6. The challenge applies to each separate language codec separately.
7. The challenge applies separately to U.S. and non-U.S. versions separately.
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
