Pre-installation tasks before running the installation program

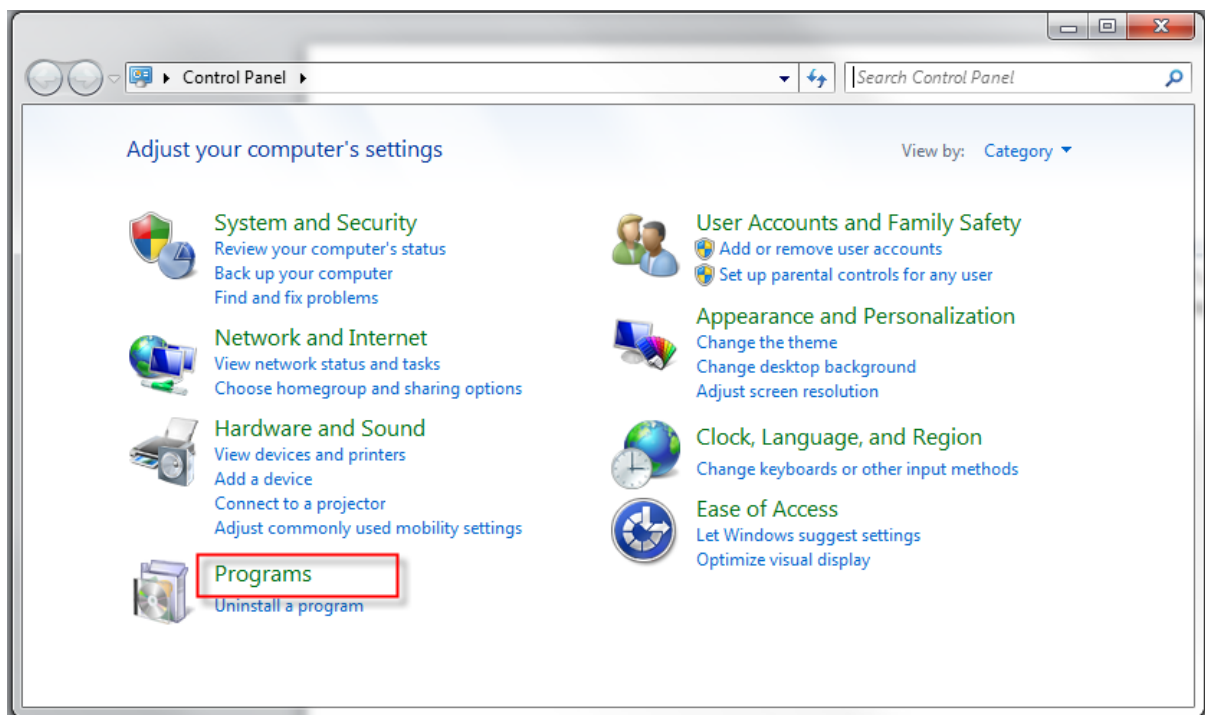

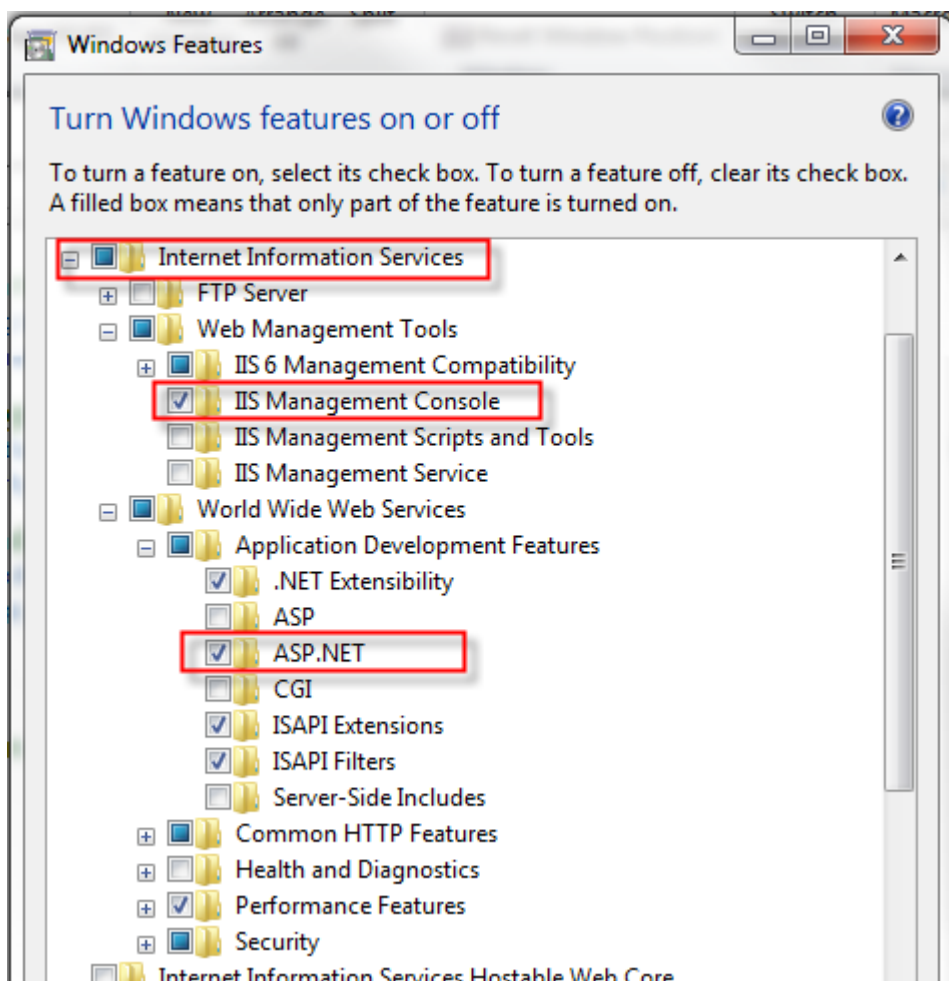
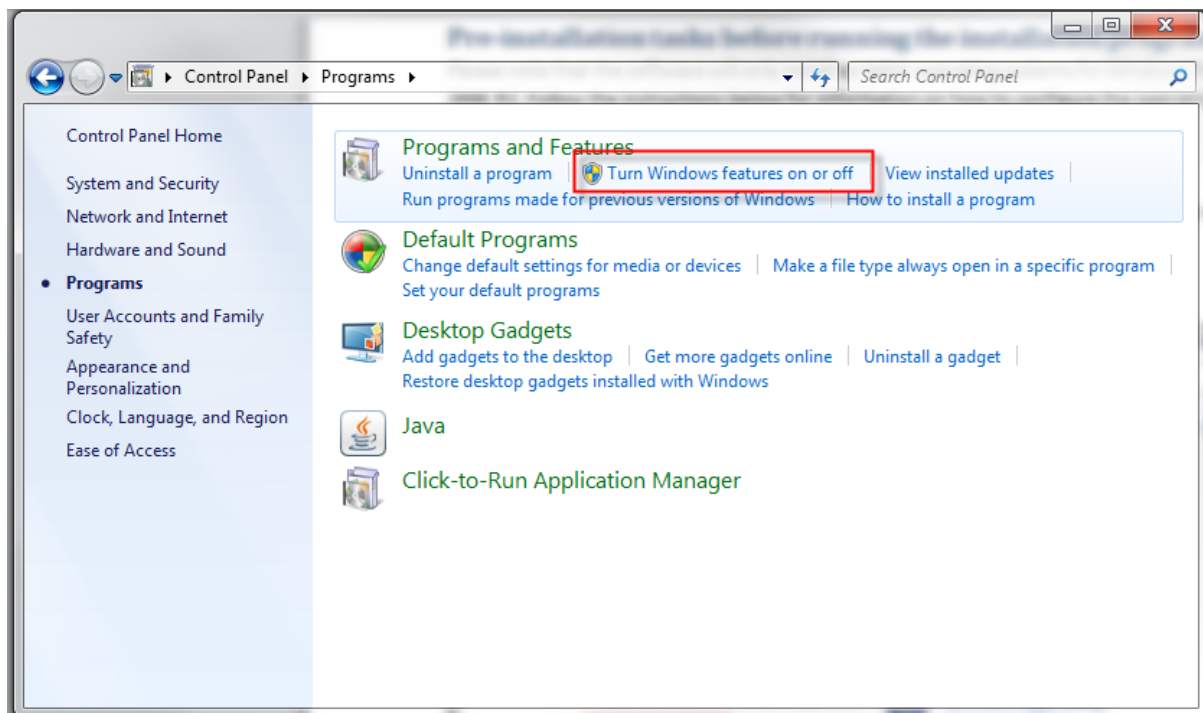
IIS Configuration

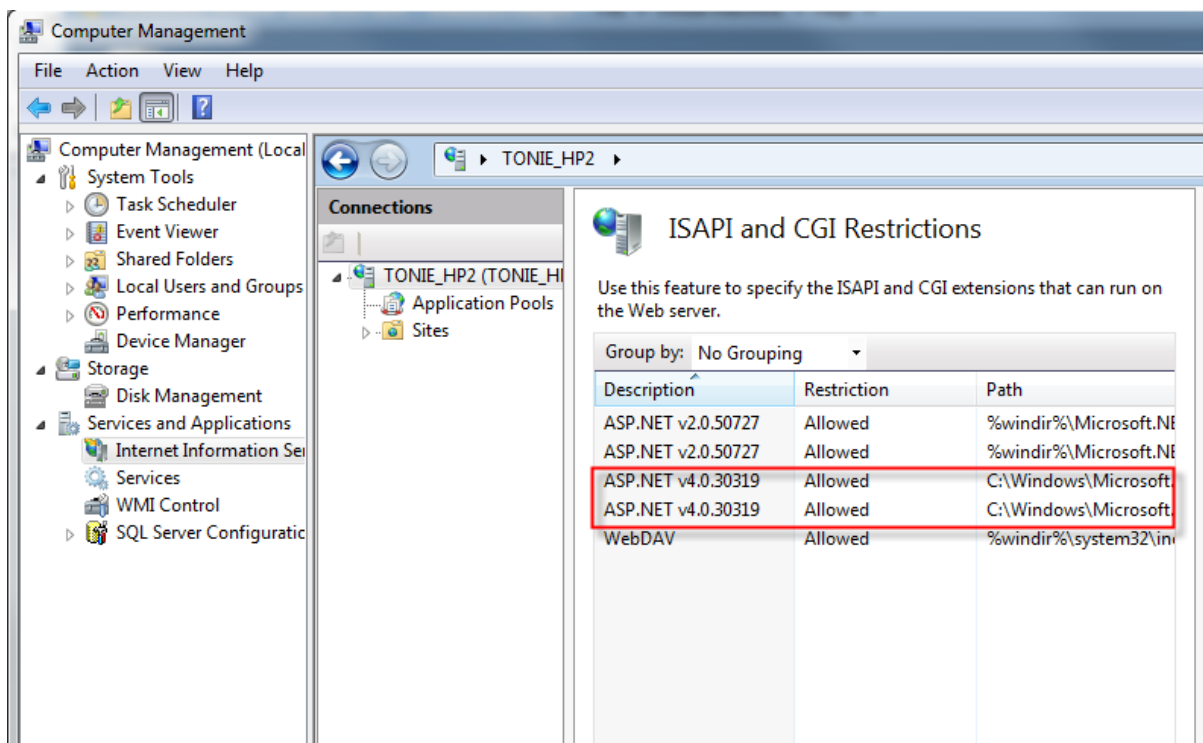
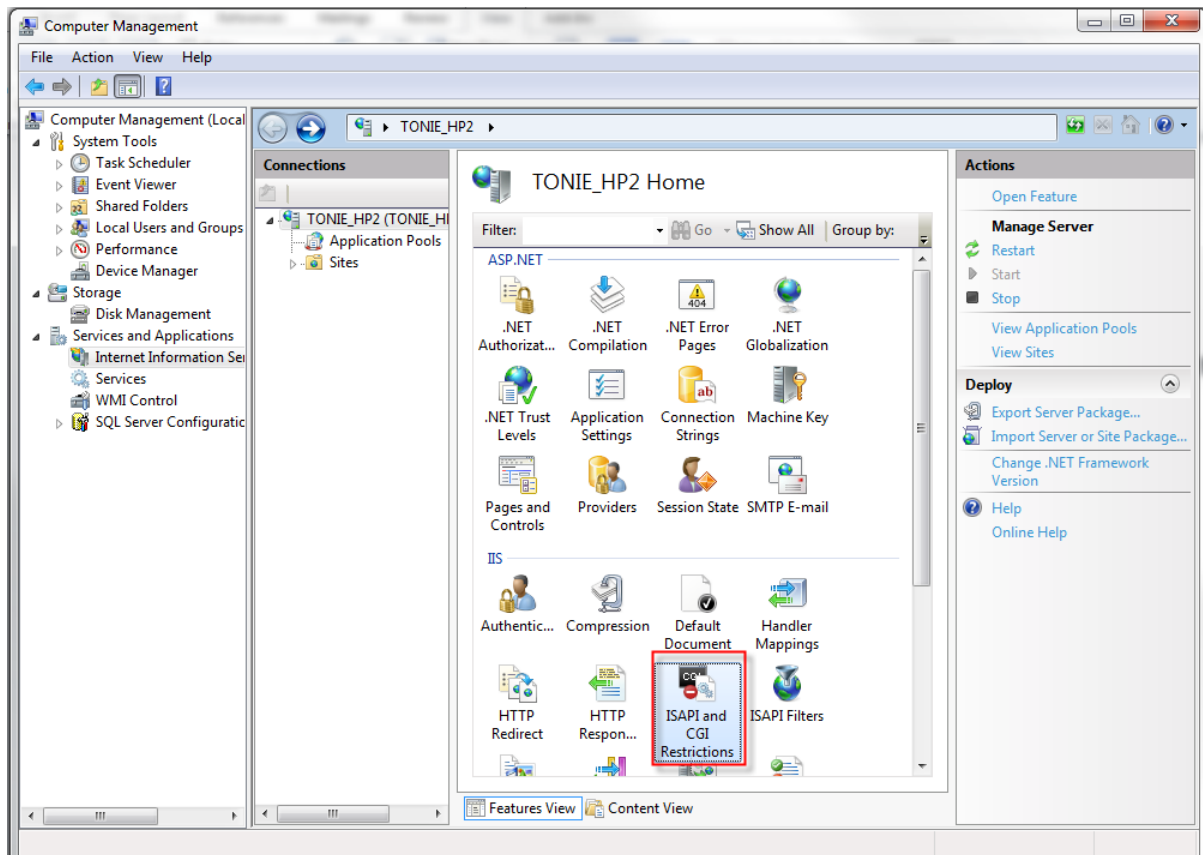
The steps below describe how to install IIS on your system. If you already have it installed, verify that the settings described below matches your system configuration.

Windows 7

Open Control panel and add/remove windows features to configure IIS

Enable ASP.NET 4.0

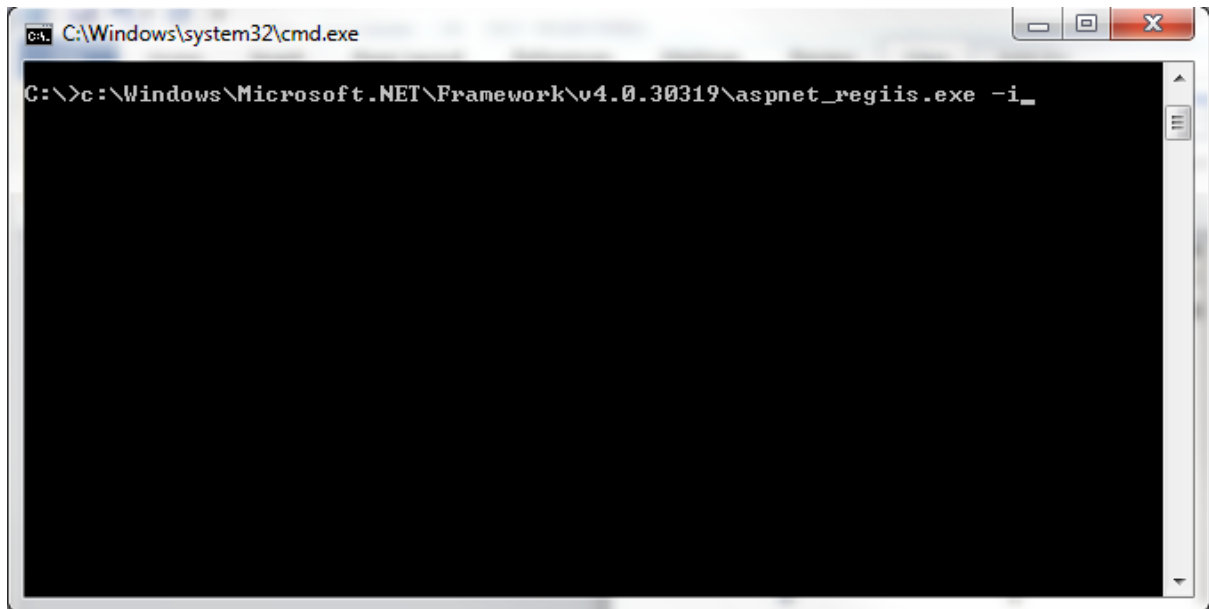


If you do not have ASP.NET 4.0 in the list proceed to install Framework4.0 and then return to this page.

.NET Framework 4.0

Verify that the .NET Framework 4 is installed and registered correctly on your system. If it is not installed, download it from Microsoft and run the installset. If it has already been installed before you added IIS to the system you need to register the framework for use in IIS. Run a dos command prompt and enter the following command at the prompt:

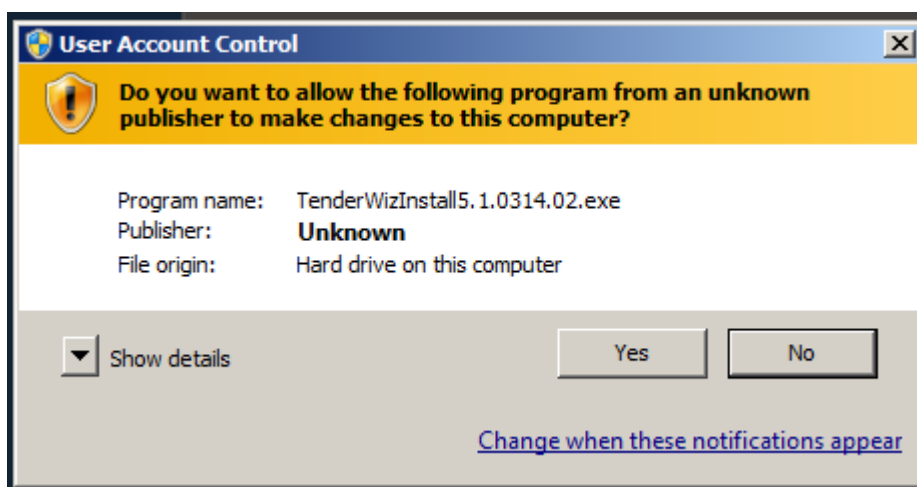
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c:\Windows\Microsoft.NET\Framework\v4.0.30319\aspnet_regiis.exe -i
```

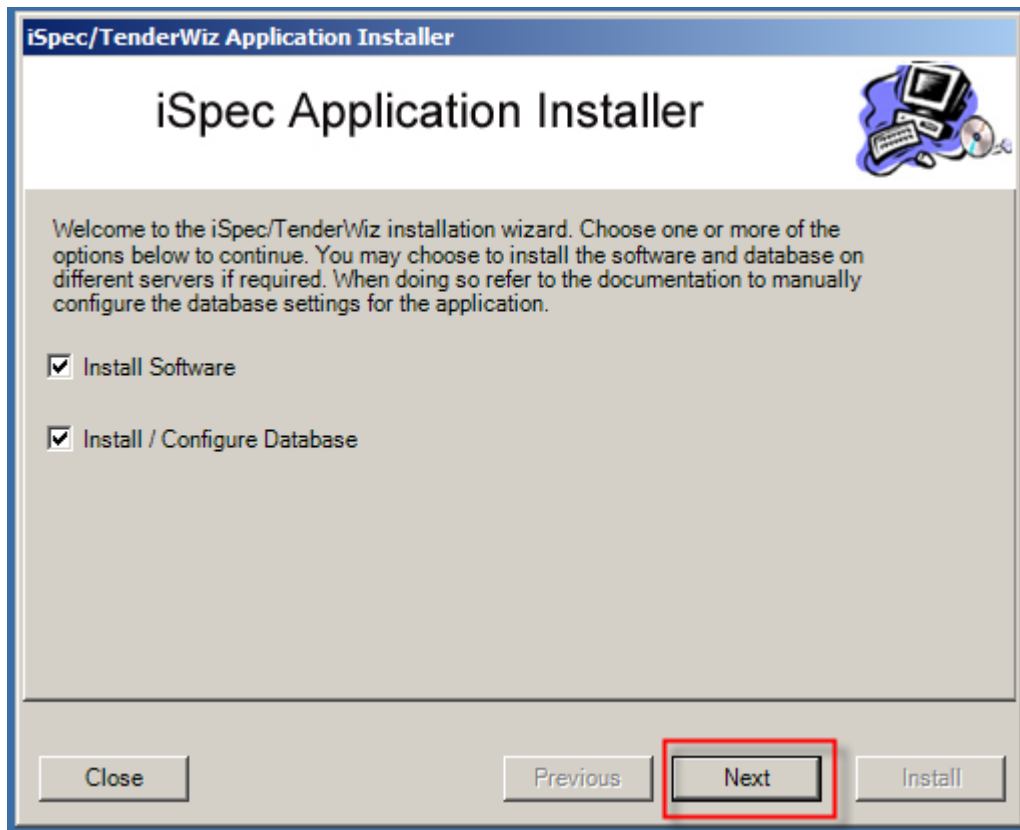


This command will register the framework with IIS

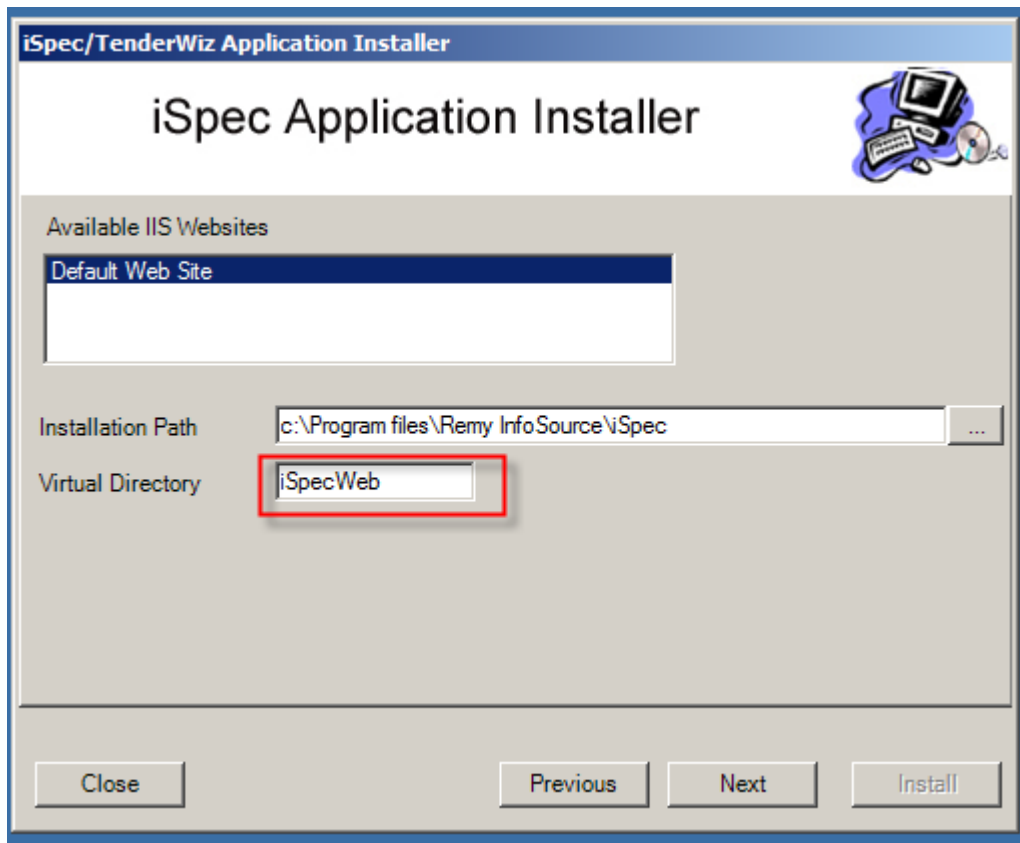
Installing the software

If IIS and Framework 4.0 have been configured correctly on the system you can run the installation program. Please note that you must have administrator rights to install the software. If you receive a security prompt, click on yes to continue

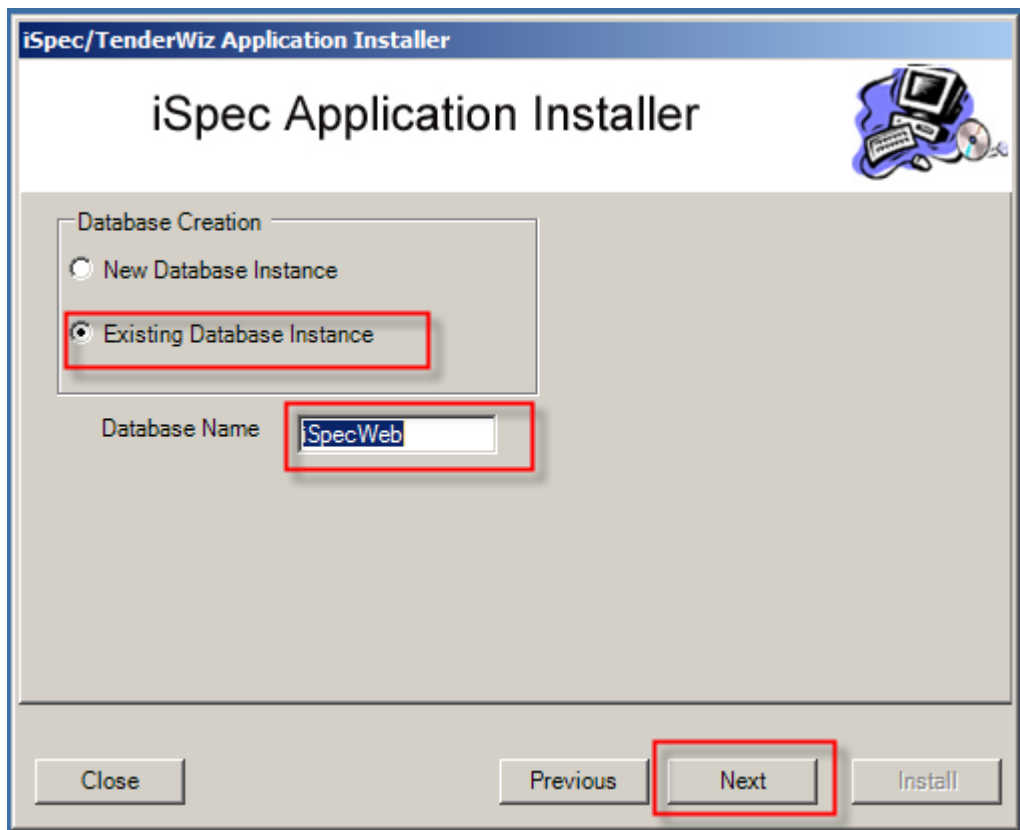




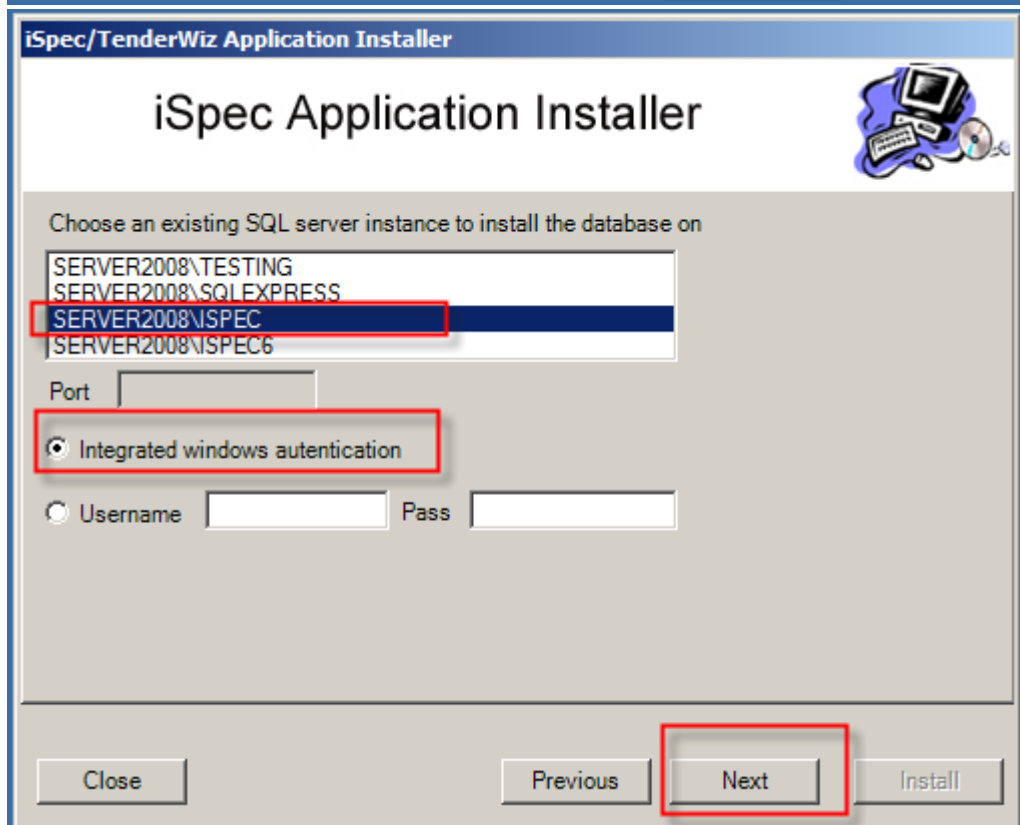
Change the virtual directory name if required. Please note that the installation program will overwrite any existing virtual directory with this name when it installs.



If you already have SQL server installed on your computer you have the option to install the database on an existing instance.

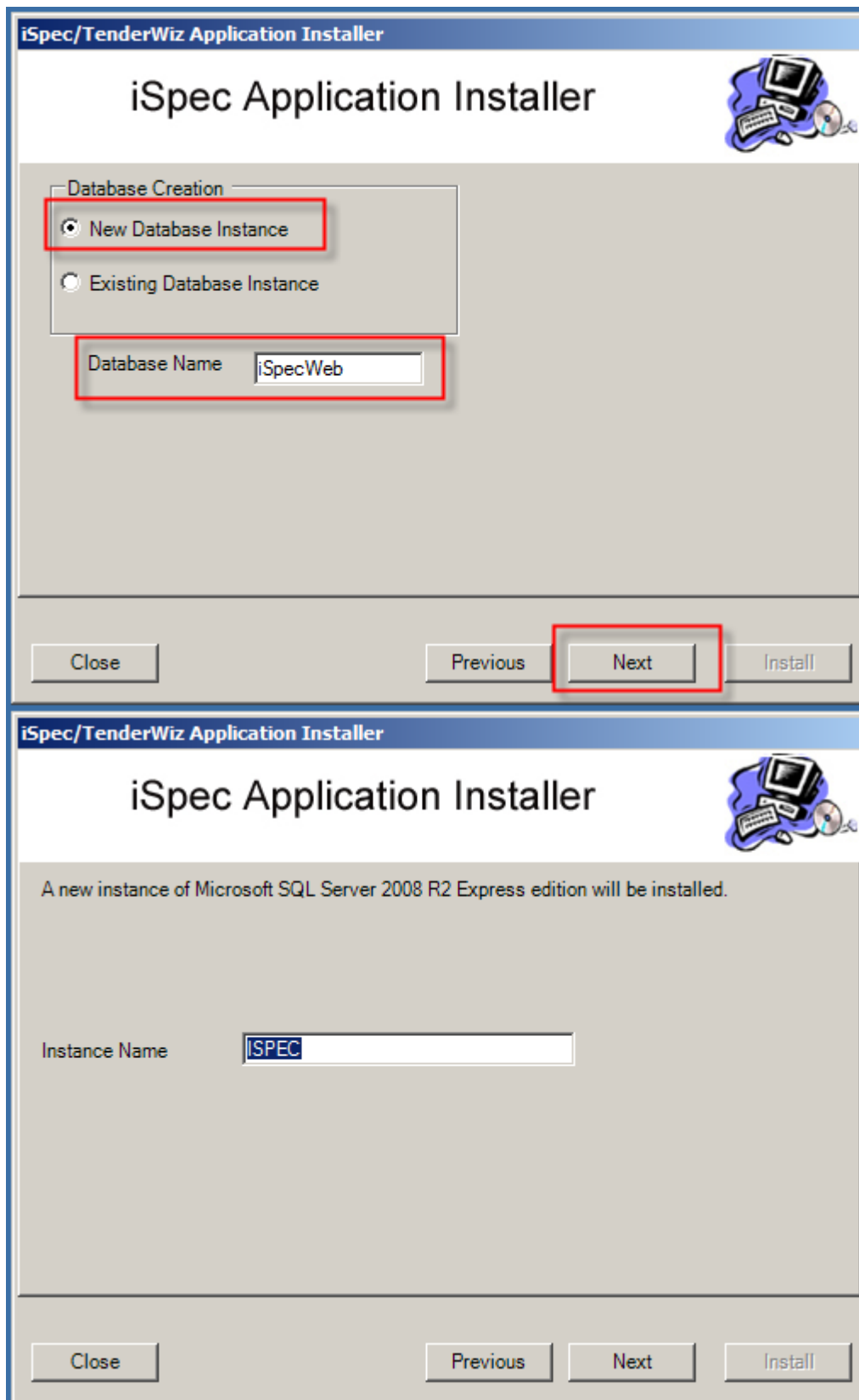

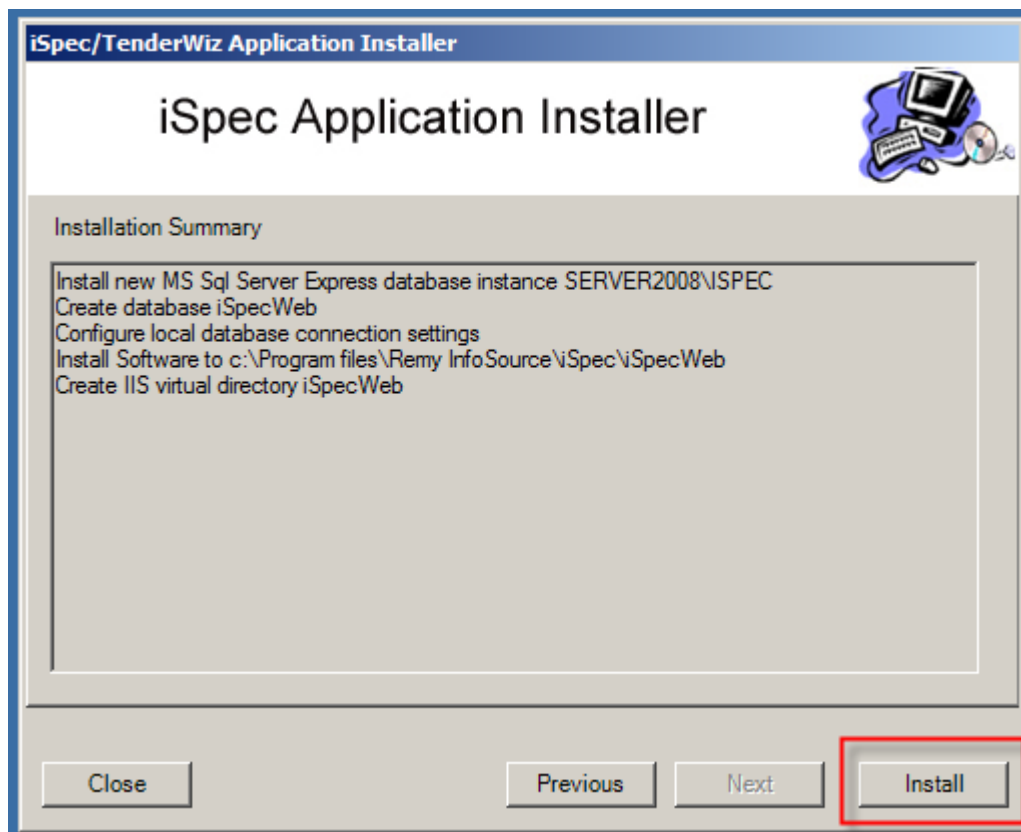
