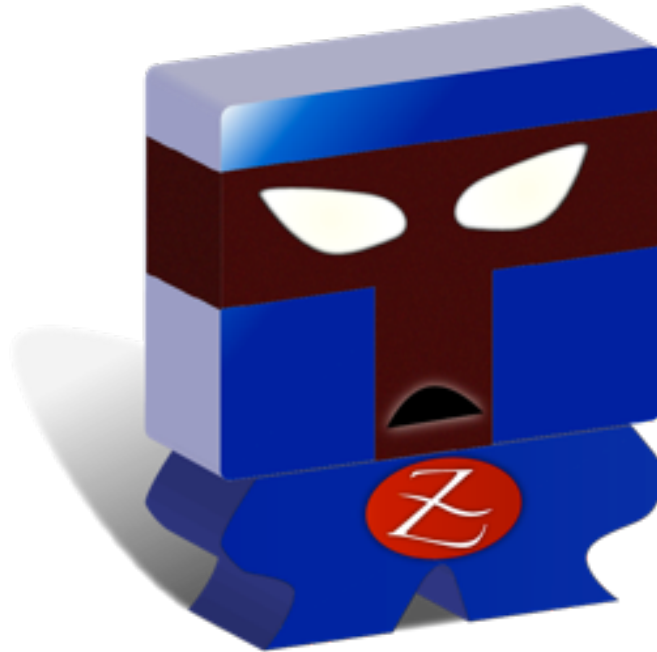


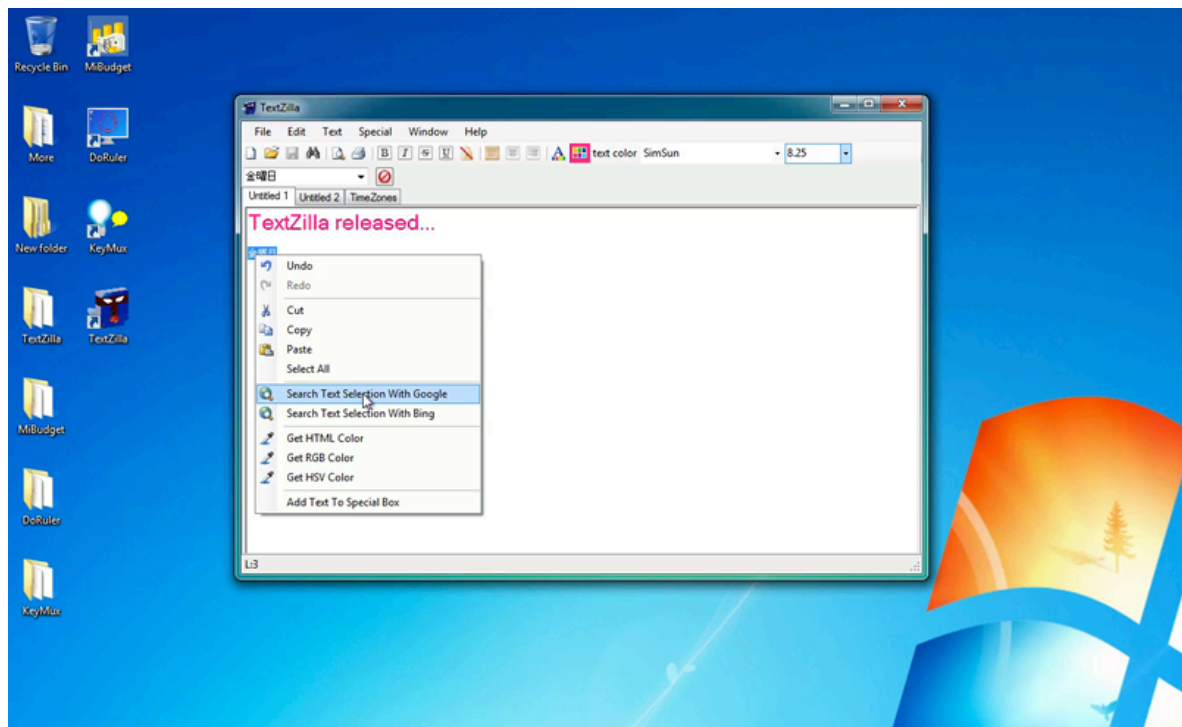

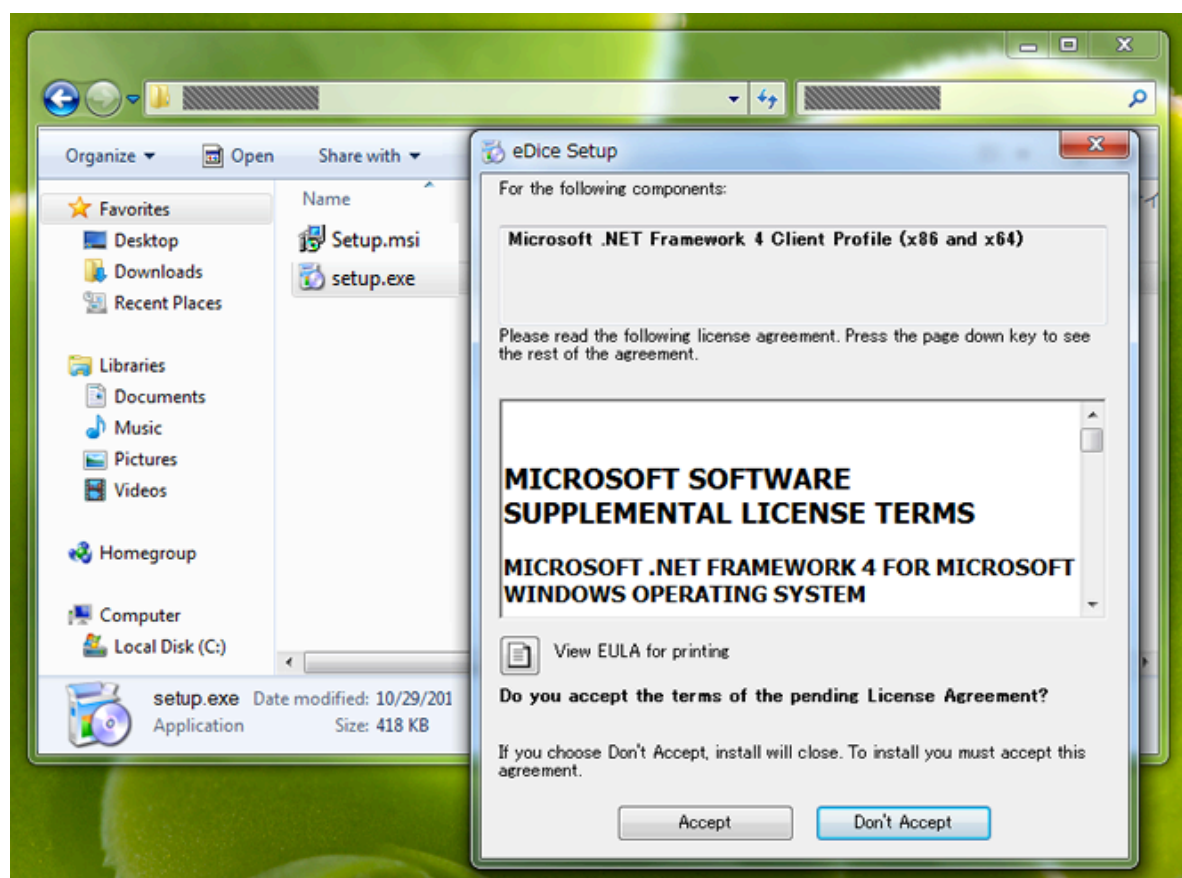

1. Introduction

TextZilla is a simple text editor that can handle multiple documents unlike Microsoft's WordPad. On top of being able to open multiple documents, users have additional features such as searching for the web for the selected word with Google/Bing, protecting a selection of text, easy access to ASCII symbols.



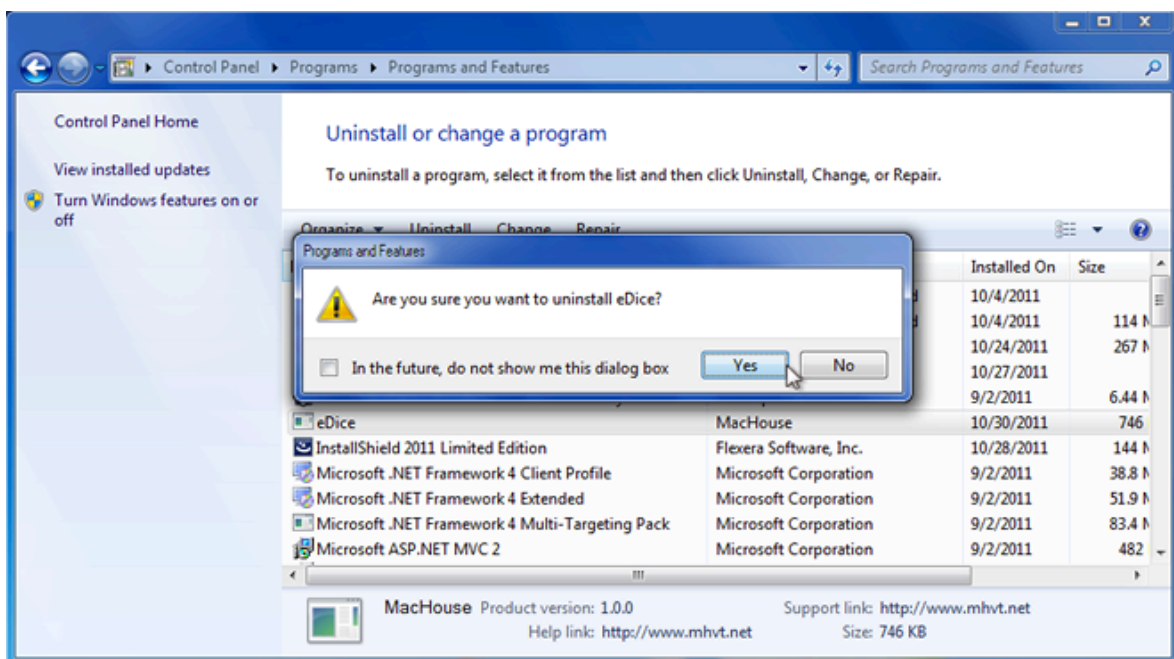

2. Installing TextZilla

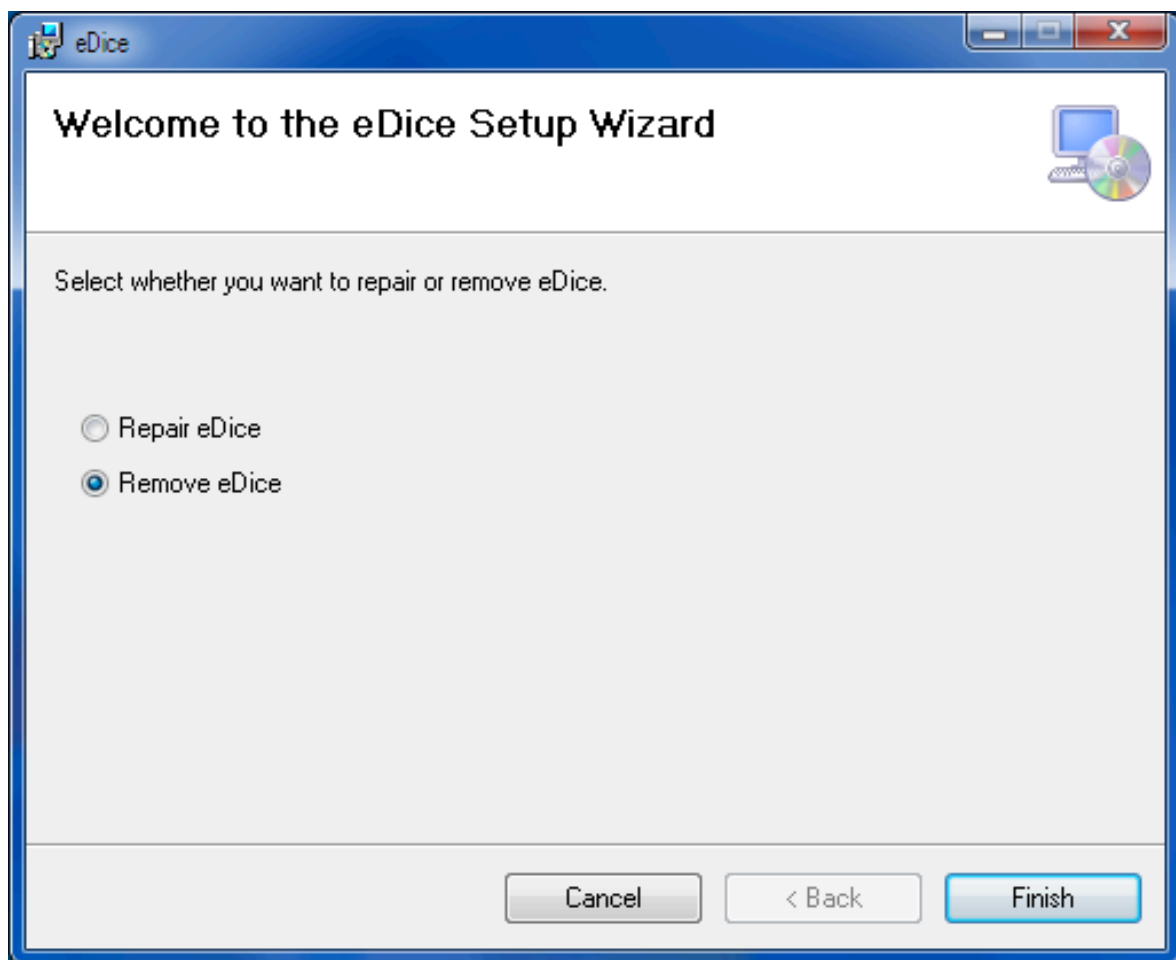
Double-click on **setup.exe** in the delivery package initiate the installation process. If your computer doesn't have it yet, TextZilla will first attempt to install **.NET Framework 4**, and you will be prompted for confirmation. (See Screenshot 2.) Then you will proceed to install TextZilla. You can use **Setup.msi** to install the application as long as you already have .NET Framework 4, which TextZilla requires. You can find the application at the following path: C:\Program Files\MacHouse\TextZilla.

3. Uninstalling TextZilla

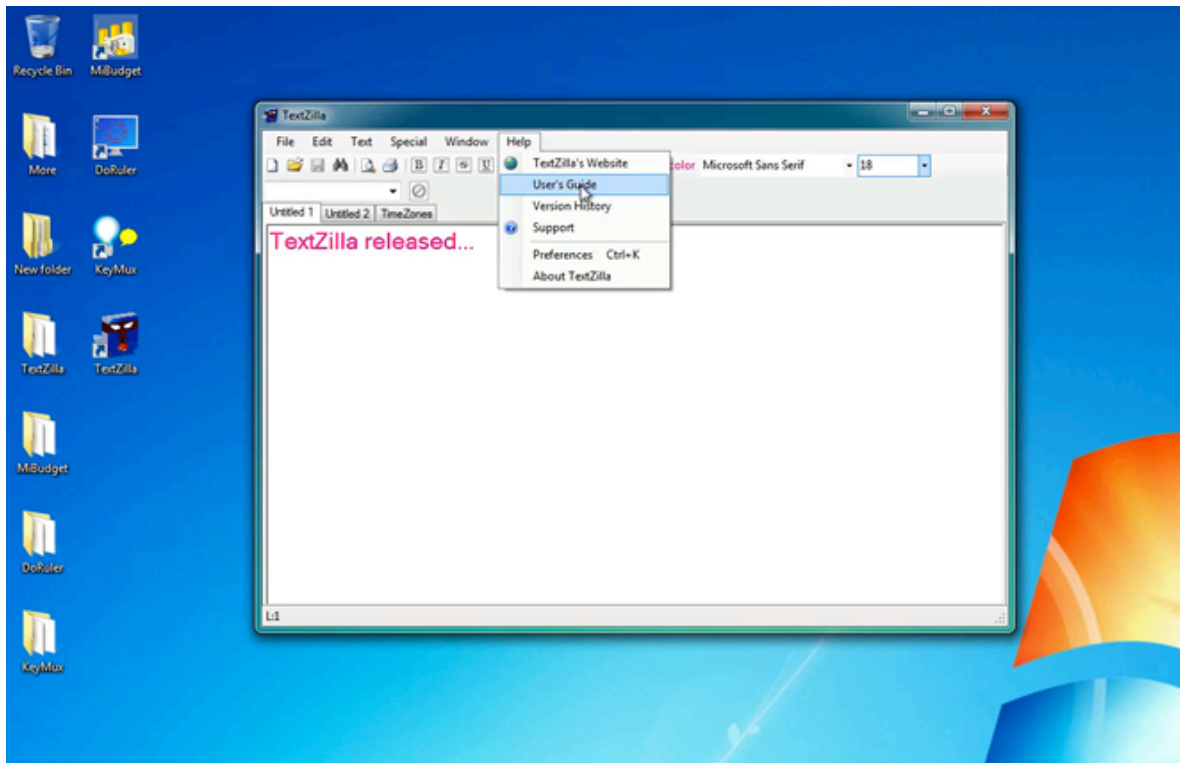
Open Control Panel and choose Uninstall a program. Then double-click on TextZilla to initiate the uninstalling process. (See Screenshot 3.) You can also use the original setup.exe or setup.msi to uninstall the application. (See Screenshot 4.) Additionally, when it starts up for the first time, the application will create a folder, which you need to manually trash. You can locate it easily by opening Preferences and navigate to the System tab.
