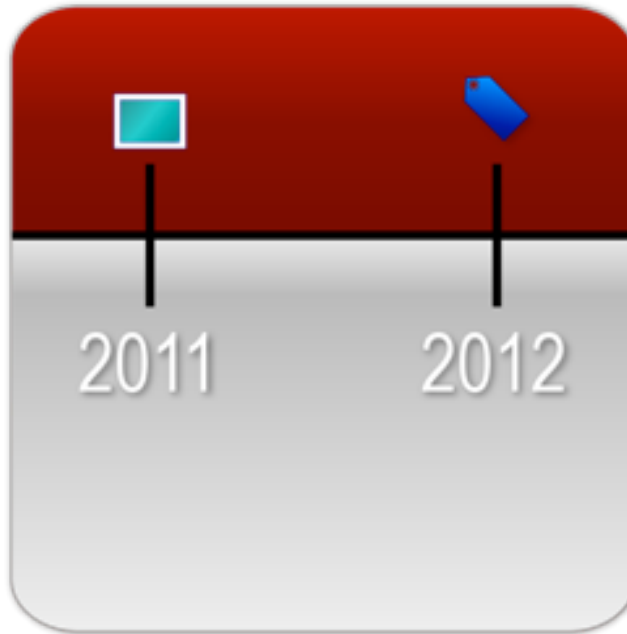


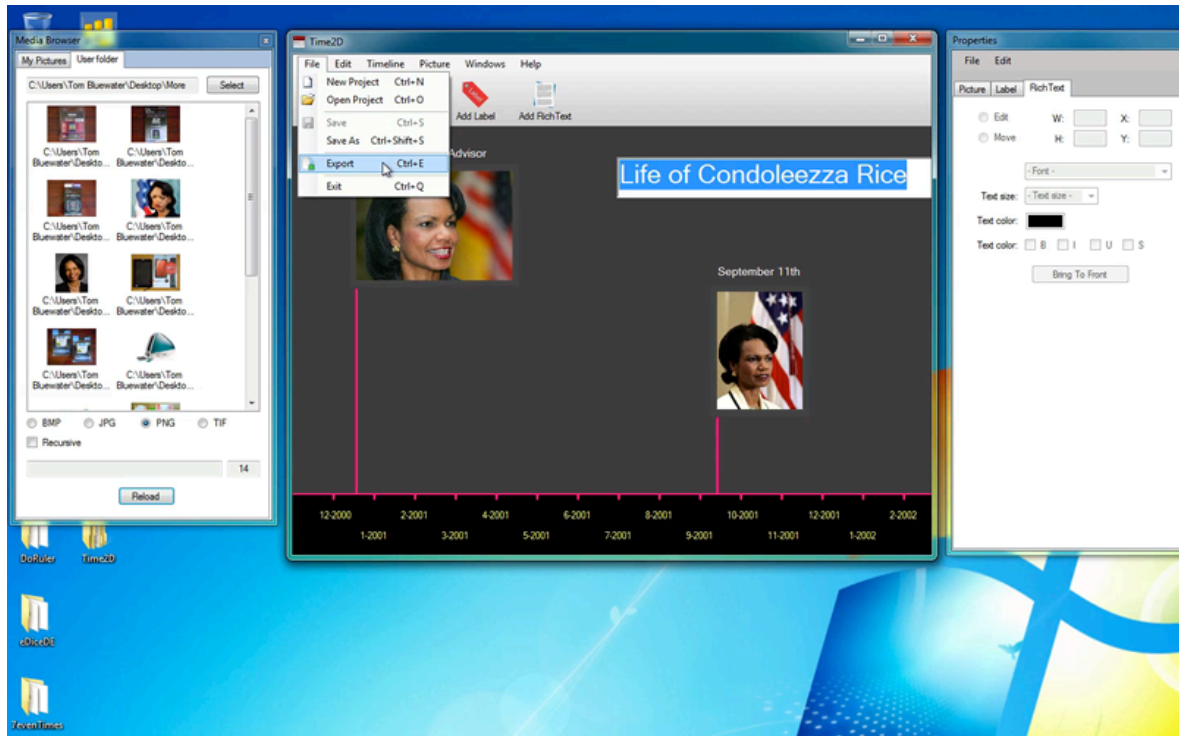
# Time2D



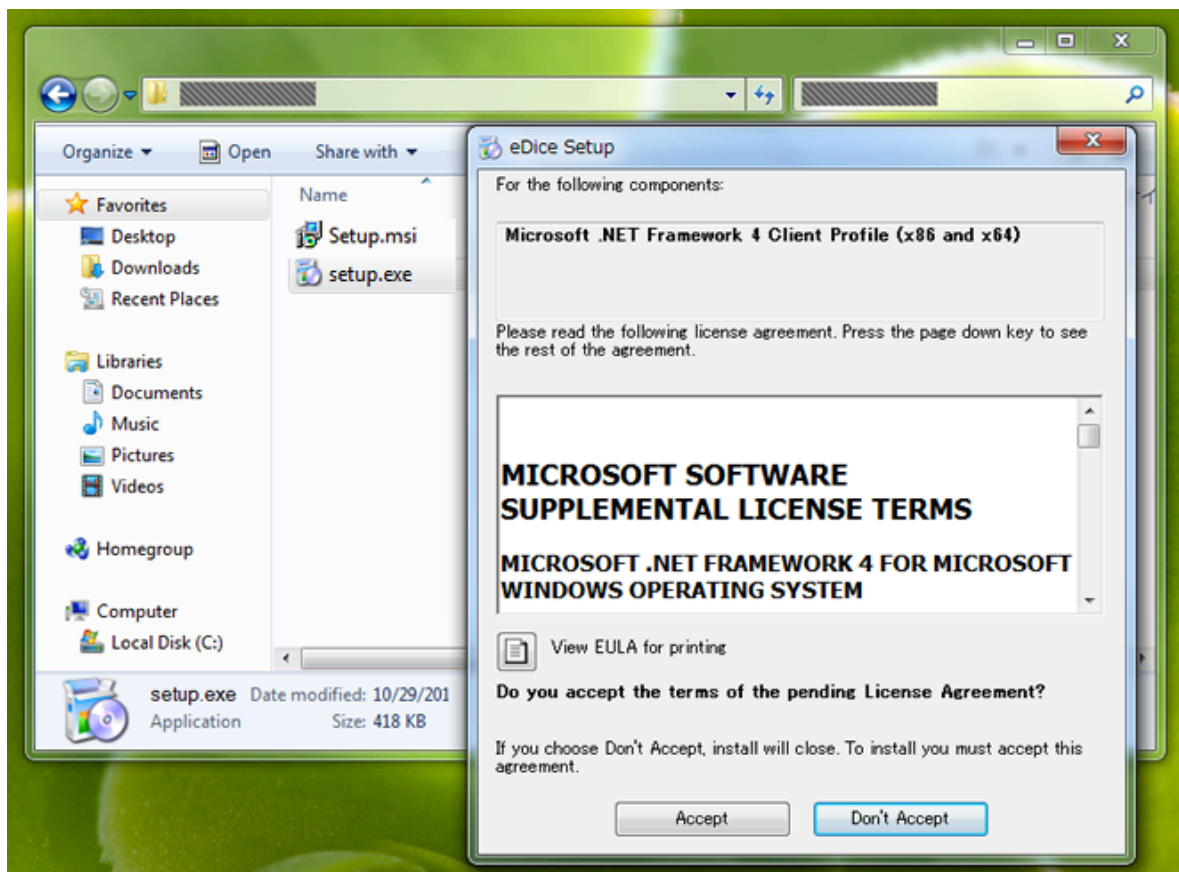

## 1. Introduction

**Time2D** is a Windows tool that allows the user to document historical events with ease. Set dates yearly, monthly or even daily. Open the Media window and double-click on a picture and easily import it into the work area. Attach as many as 512 labels and RichText fields. You can save your progress by choosing File > Save As. Then open the file by choosing File > Open Project.



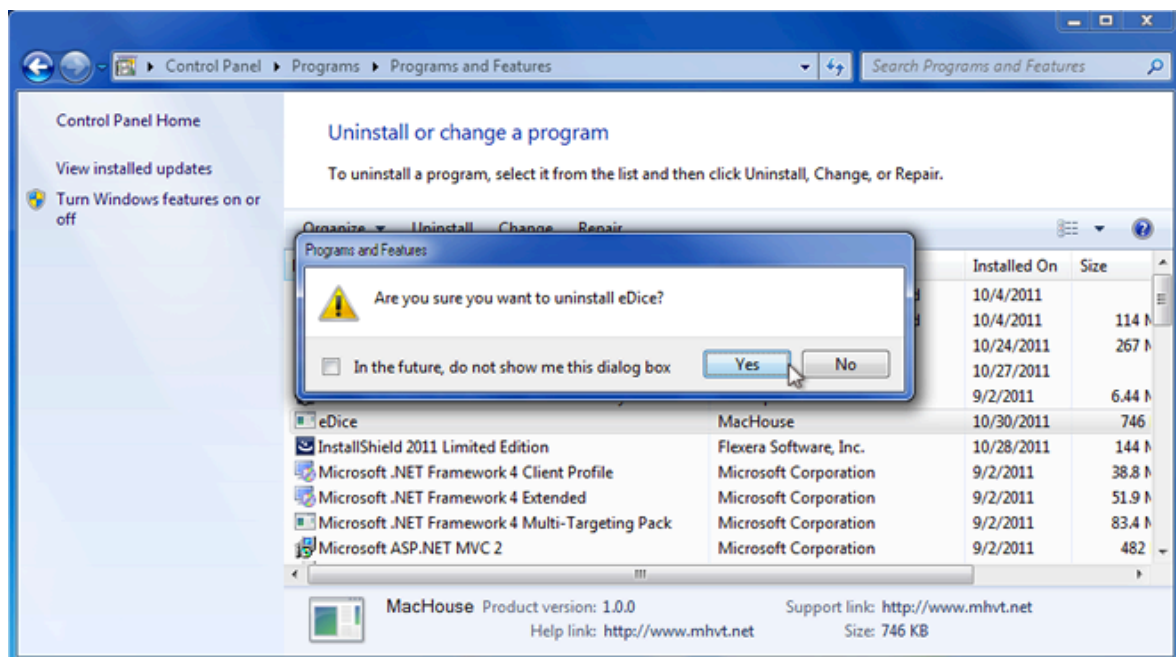

### 2. Installing Time2D

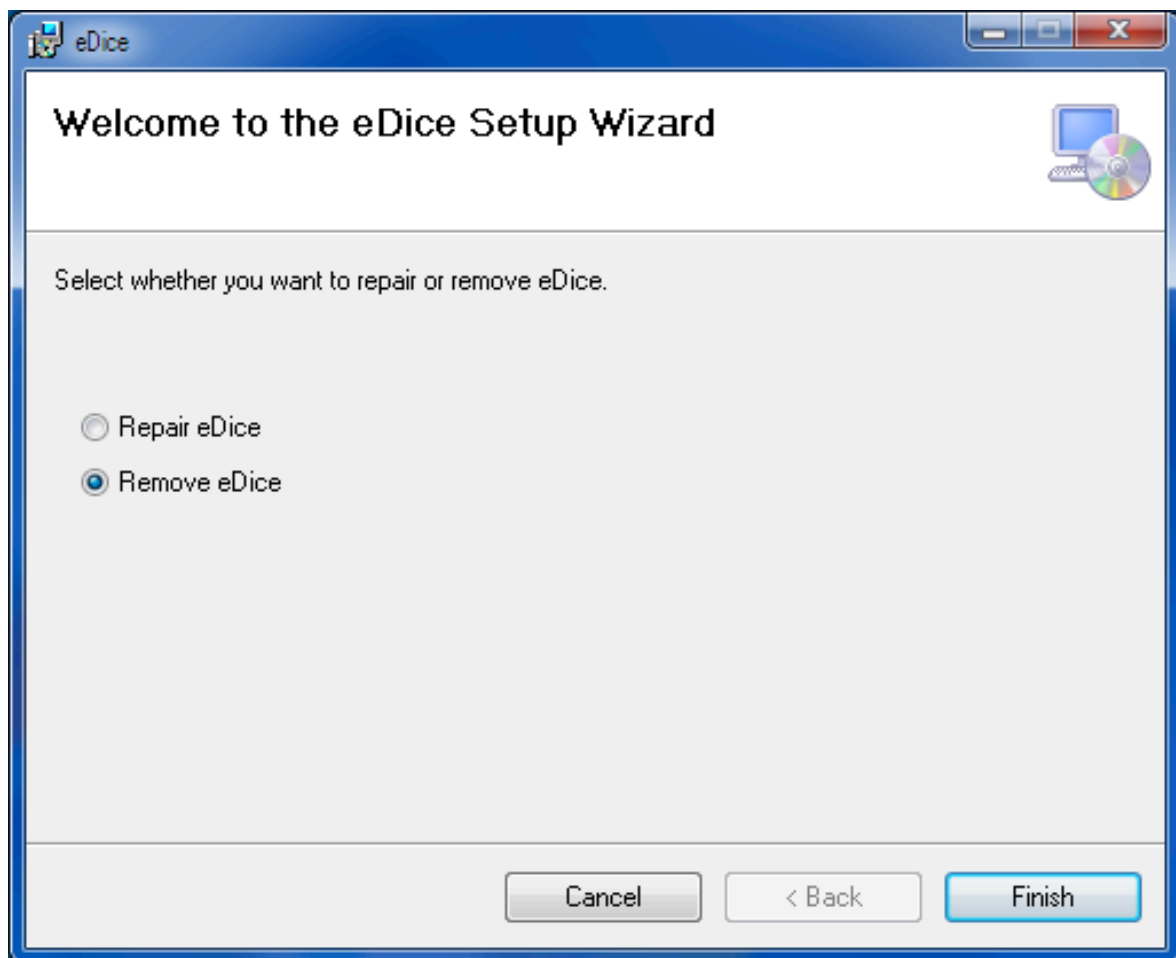
Double-click on **setup.exe** in the delivery package initiate the installation process. If your computer doesn't have it yet, Time2D will first attempt to install **.NET Framework 4**, and you will be prompted for confirmation. (See Screenshot 2.) Then you will proceed to install Time2D. You can use **Setup.msi** to install the application as long as you already have .NET Framework 4, which Time2D requires. You can find the application at the following path: C:\Program Files\MacHouse\Time2D.

### 3. Uninstalling Time2D

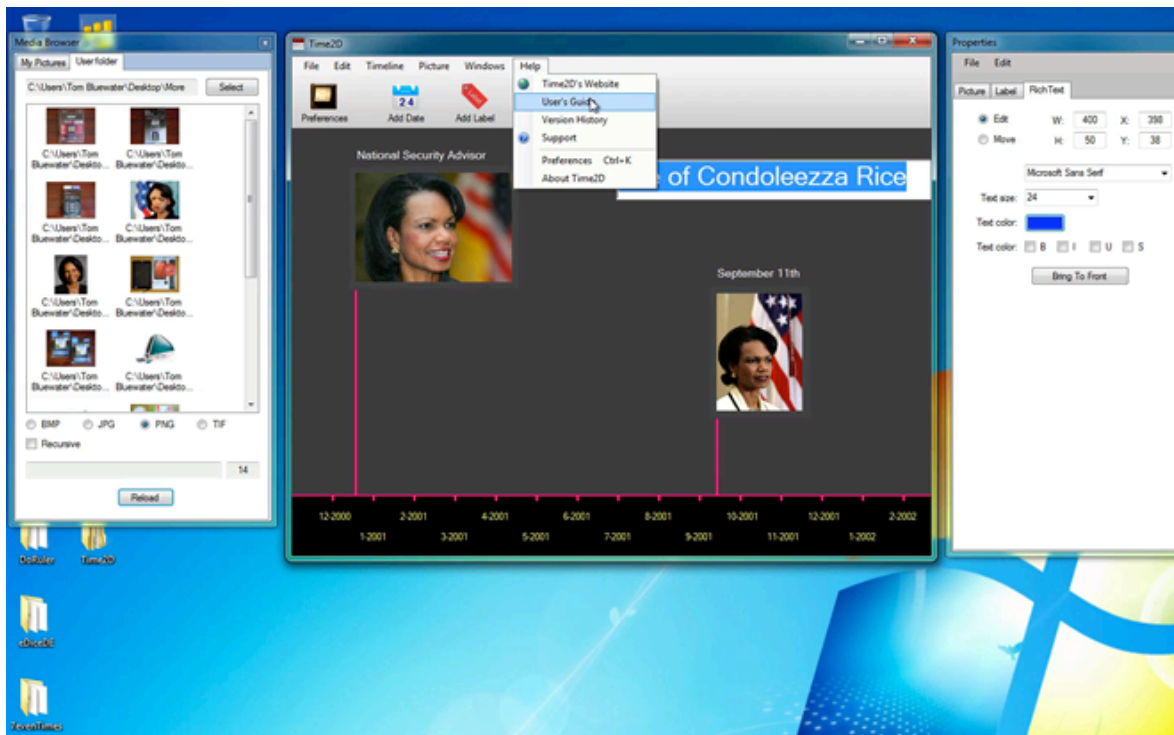
Open Control Panel and choose Uninstall a program. Then double-click on Time2D to initiate the uninstalling process. (See Screenshot 3.) You can also use the original setup.exe or setup.msi to uninstall the application. (See Screenshot 4.) Additionally, when it starts up for the first time, the application will create a folder, which you need to manually trash. You can locate it easily by opening Preferences and navigate to the System tab.
